Foundations - Law  
Pastor Logan Ames

Deuteronomy 18:20 (NIV) – "But a prophet who presumes to speak in my name anything I have not commanded, or a prophet who speaks in the name of other gods, is to be put to death".

Deuteronomy 18:21-22 (NIV) – You may say to yourselves, "How can we know when a message has not been spoken by the Lord?" If what a prophet proclaims in the name of the Lord does not take place or come true, that is a message the Lord has not spoken. That prophet has spoken presumptuously, so do not be alarmed.

James 2:10 (NIV) – "For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles at just one point is guilty of breaking all of it".

James 4:11-12 (NIV) – "Brothers and sisters, do not slander one another. Anyone who speaks against a brother or sister or judges them speaks against the law and judges it. When you judge the law, you are not keeping it, but sitting in judgment on it. There is only one Lawgiver and Judge, the One who is able to save and destroy. But you – who are you to judge your neighbor?"

James 2:12-13 (NIV) – "Speak and act as those who are going to be judged by the law that gives freedom, because judgment without mercy will be shown to anyone who has not been merciful. Mercy triumphs over judgment".

Genesis 2:16-17 (NIV) – And the Lord God commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat from it you will certainly die".

Proverbs 29:18 (NLT) – "When people do not accept divine guidance, they run wild. But whoever obeys the law is joyful".

Judges 21:23-25 (NIV) – "So that is what the Benjamites did. While the young women were dancing, each man caught one and carried her off to be his wife. Then they returned to their inheritance and rebuilt the towns and settled in them. At that time the Israelites left that place and went home to their tribes and clans, each to his own inheritance. In those days Israel had no king; everyone did as they saw fit".

Exodus 19:12-13 (NIV) – Put limits for the people around the mountain and tell them, "Be careful that you do not approach the mountain or touch the foot of it. Whoever touches the mountain is to be put to death. They are to be stoned or shot with arrows; not a hand is to be laid on them. No person or animal shall be permitted to live. Only when the ram's horn sounds a long blast may they approach the mountain".

John 1:16-17 (NIV) – "Out of His fullness we have all received grace in place of grace already given. For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ".

Deuteronomy 30:15-18 (NIV) – "See, I set before you today life and prosperity, death and destruction. For I command you today to love the Lord your God, to walk in obedience to Him, and to keep His commands, decrees, and laws; then you will live and increase, and the Lord your God will bless you in the land you are entering to possess. But if your heart turns away and you are not obedient, and if you are drawn away to bow down to other gods and worship them, I declare to you this day that you will certainly be destroyed. You will not live long in the land you are crossing the Jordan to enter and possess".

Matthew 5:17 (NKJV) – "Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill".

Hebrews 10:1 (NIV) – "The law is only a shadow of the good things that are coming – not the realities themselves. For this reason, it can never, by the same sacrifices repeatedly endlessly year after year, make perfect those who draw near to worship".

Romans 10:4 (NIV) – "Christ is the culmination of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes".

Bottom Line – Key Points

1. Regarding obedience to God's law, all have fallen short and therefore have no right to judge one another.
2. Apart from the law, the people had no way to know righteousness; therefore, the law is an act of grace.
3. Since the law itself could not change the internal problem of sin in people, Christ came as our sacrifice.
