


1 Corinthians 11:1

Luke 10:41-42




4 Nevertheless I have *this* against you, that you have left your first love. 5 Remember therefore from where you have fallen

Pride = Thinking higher of yourself











Mark 12:28-31




Definition of Humility


Pride = Thinking higher of yourself




Saying about yourself what God says about you
