#### Psalm 115:16


The heaven, even the heavens, are the Lord's; But the earth He has given to the children of men.

- 4. He would be betrayed for 30 pieces of silver. (Zechariah 11:12)
- 5. He would be mocked. (Psalm 22:7,8)
- 6. He would be pierced. (Psalms 22:16)
- 7. He would die with the wicked, but He would be buried with the rich. (Isaiah 53:9)

- 13. To give us a clear conscience.

- 15. To deliver to us every spiritual blessing from God.

- 17. To make us His own.
