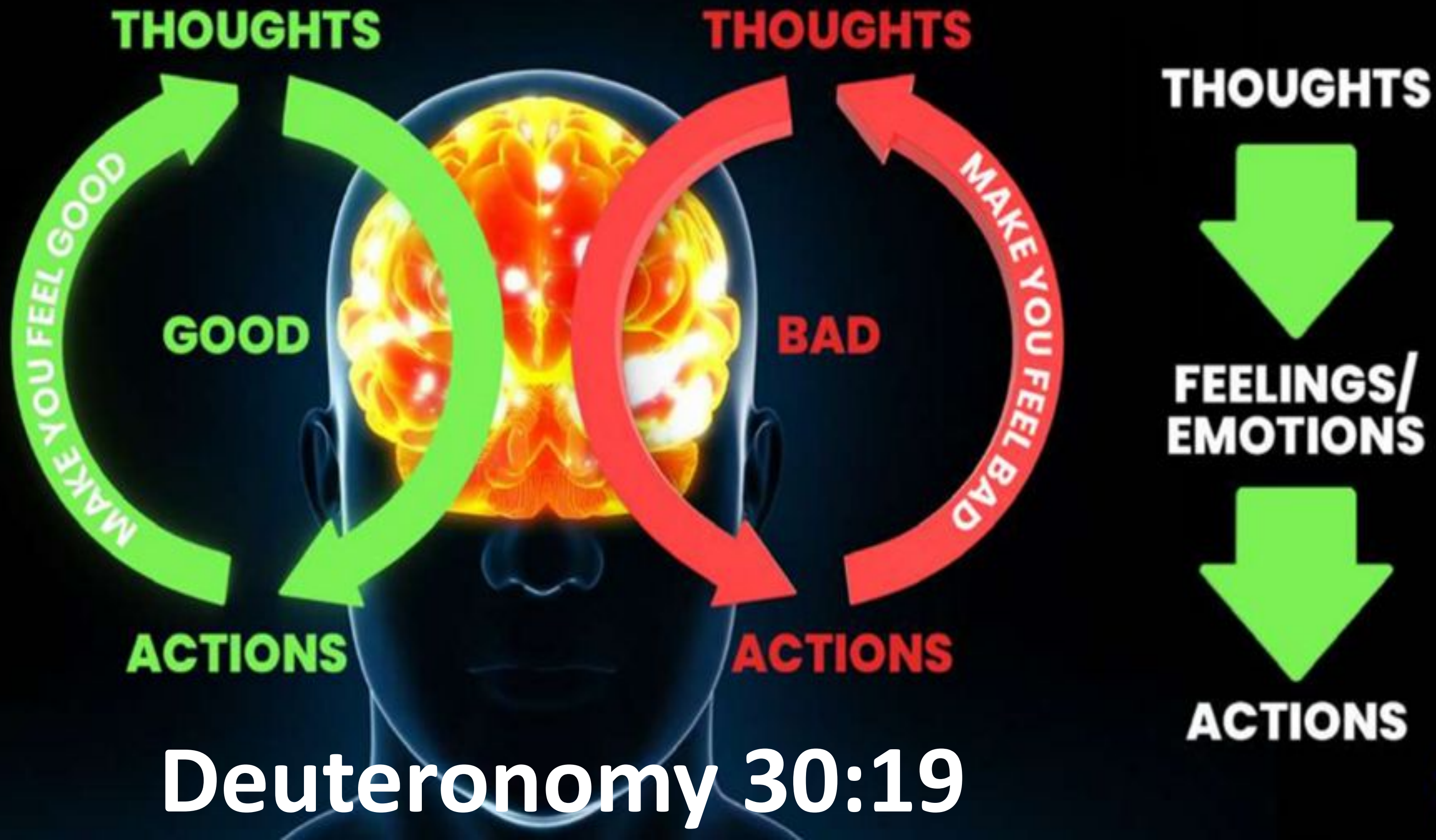

Probability

- ❖ What is the chance it lands on heads?
- ❖ $= \frac{1}{2}$
- ❖ What is the chance of the next person throwing heads?
- ❖ $= \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2} = \frac{1}{4} = 25\%$
- ❖ What is the chance of 10 people in a row landing on heads?
- ❖ $= \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2}$
 $\times \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2} = 1/1024 = 0.098 \%$

1. To show His own love for us.
2. To carry our sorrows and griefs.
3. To learn obedience in His suffering and be perfected as the source of eternal salvation.
4. To show the wealth of God's love and grace for sinners.
5. To cancel the legal demands of the Law against us.
6. To become a ransom for many.
7. For the forgiveness of our sins.
8. To provide the basis for our justification.
9. To restore the abundant life that was lost in the garden of Eden.
10. To take away our condemnation.
11. To serve.
12. To make us holy, blameless, and perfect.
13. To give us a clear conscience.
14. To destroy the hostility between races and ethnics.
15. To deliver to us every spiritual blessing from God.
16. To be the image of God.
17. To make us His own.
18. To obtain for us all things that are good for us.
19. To demonstrate the deepest meaning of marriage.
20. To demonstrate true humility and costly love.
21. To heal us from moral and physical sickness.
22. To reconcile us to God.
23. To save sinners.
24. To give us confident access into the very presence of God.
25. To reveal God's love for sinners.
