Psalm 89:34

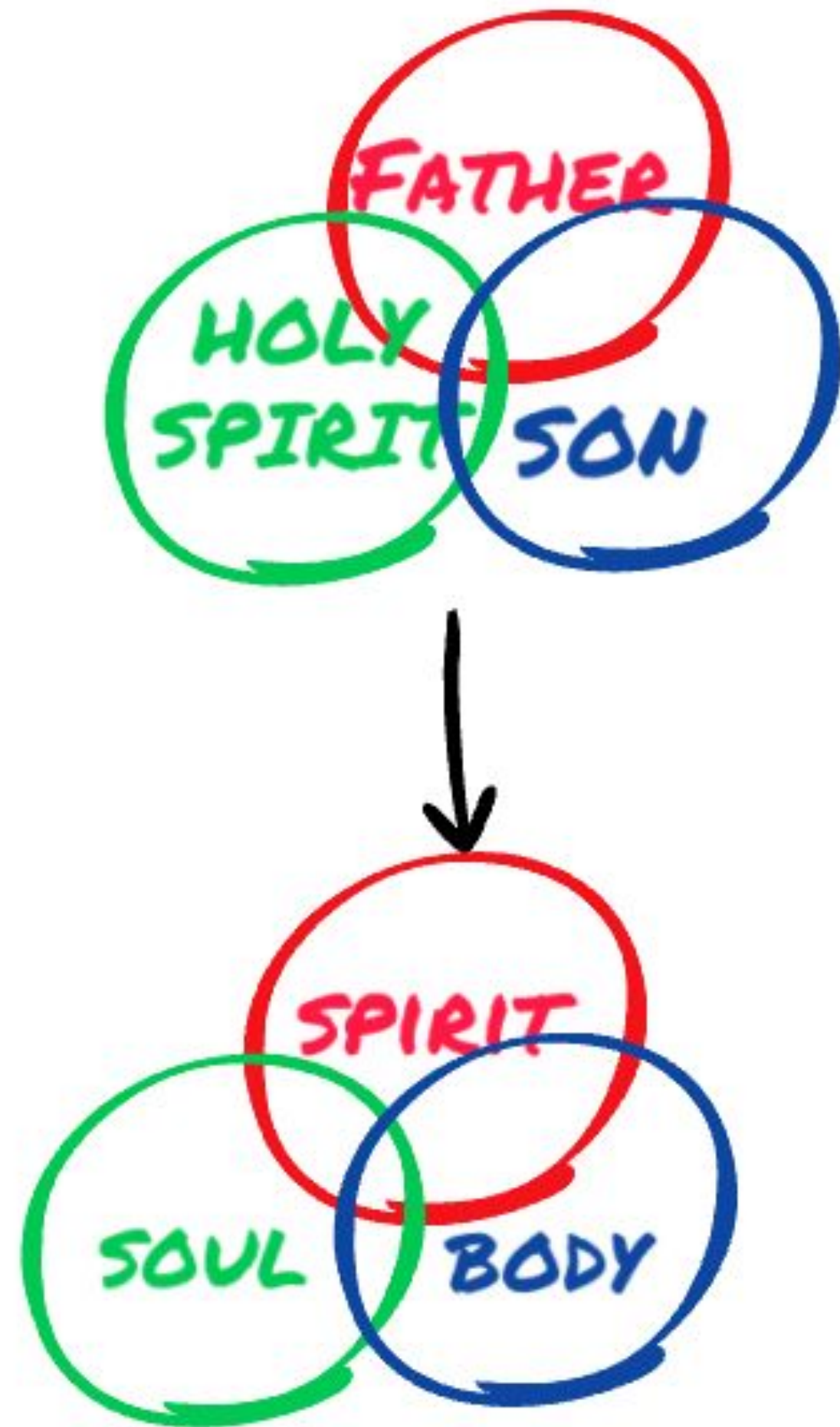
My covenant I will not break,

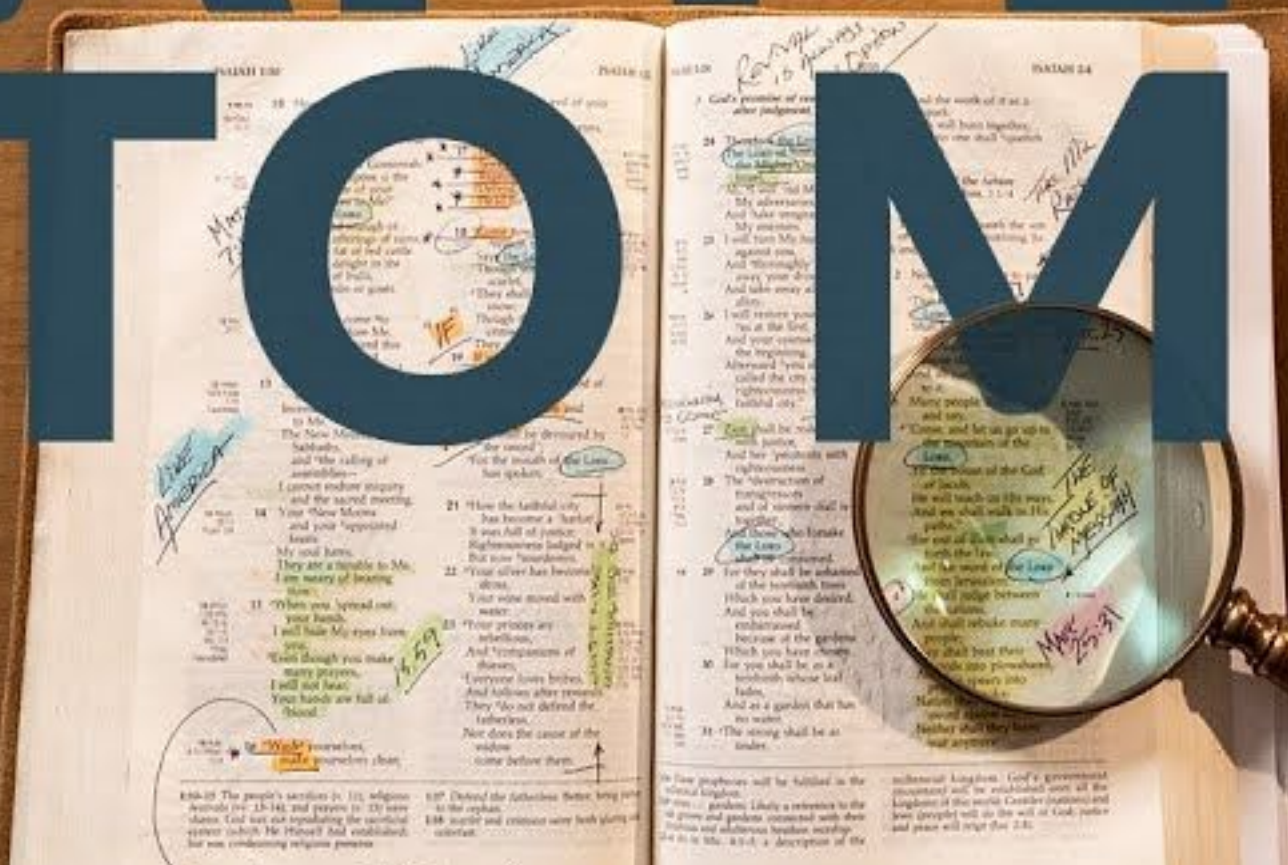
