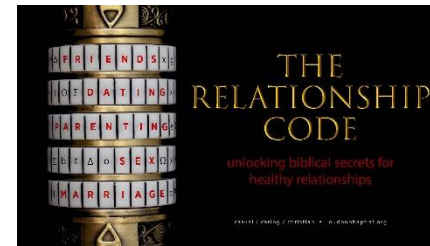
- Memorize John 15:12-13
