
Nehemiah 6:1-2




Nehemiah 6:3-4




Nehemiah 6:5-6


Nehemiah 6:7-9




Nehemiah 6:10-11

Nehemiah 6:12-14




Nehemiah saw that in compromise you <u>always</u> give up something.
