


Nameless Mothers



And in all the land there were no women so beautiful as Job's daughters. And their father gave them an inheritance among their brothers.





- Keep my faith in the God who takes the ashes and turns them into great beauty. Is. 61:3




Ichabod's mother 1 Samuel 4:19-22





- Ichabod lives to restore the Levites to honor God. My legacy will live on by God's grace.




