"The Temple of the Living God"

2 Corinthians 6:4–7:1

Read Chapter 6 & 7:1

Observation (What Does the Passage Say?)

1. What image does Paul use in 2 Corinthians 6:14 to describe spiritual compromise?
2. What five contrasts does Paul present in verses 14–16?
3. What promises does God give His people in 2 Corinthians 6:16–18?

Interpretation (What Does It Mean?)

1. Why is the image of the temple of the living God central to Paul's argument?
2. What does Paul mean by being "unequally yoked" with unbelievers?
3. How does Paul connect covenant identity with holiness and separation??

Correlation (How Does it Relate to Other Passages?)

1. How does John 17:15–18 help explain the balance between engagement with the world and spiritual separation?
2. How does 1 Corinthians 3:16 and 6:19 expand the meaning of believers as God's temple?
3. How does Revelation 21:3 connect with Paul's promise that God will dwell among His people?

Application (How Can I Apply It to My Life?)

1. Are there influences, relationships, or habits slowly shaping your heart away from wholehearted devotion to Christ?
2. What "small leaks" or compromises might the Holy Spirit be exposing in your life?
3. How can you guard the treasure of the gospel within your heart more intentionally this week?

Response (What Should My Response Be?)

1. What is one area where God is calling you to pursue greater holiness?
2. Have you allowed divided affections or worldly thinking to dull your love for Christ?
3. What practical steps can you take this week to cleanse the temple and renew your devotion to God?
