1 Peter 1:13-21

Big Idea: Holiness is a separation **FROM** our former manner of living **UNTO** God.

- It is the result of obedience
- Scripture commands holiness
- Based on the price Jesus paid.

GRACE GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Verse 16 quotes Leviticus 20:26. How is God's holiness different from our holiness?
2. How do verses 14-16 describe the relationship between holiness and obedience?
3. What does Peter mean by "prepare your minds for action, keep sober in spirit, fix your hope completely on the grace"?
4. What is the meaning of "redeemed" in v. 18? How is the blood of Jesus connected to this redemption?
5. In verse 18, Peter refers to "your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers". What way of life is he referring to?
6. What does "foreknown before the foundation of the world" mean in verse 20? What is the significance of the phrase "has appeared in these last times"?
7. How is believing in God to be distinguished from believing about God?
