

Paul Kreitzer - Elder John 3:1-22-36

BIG IDEA of John's Gospel: Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

TODAY'S BIG IDEA: He must increase and I must decrease.

From our passage today, we encounter the heart of John the Baptist as it relates to who Jesus is (as the bridegroom) and who John is (as the friend of the bridegroom).

- The Joy in Glorifying Christ 3:27-30
- The Logic of Glorifying Christ 3:31-36
