Ephesians 4:7-16 (week of Nov 24, 2019)

Spend some time catching up and talking story.

Spend some time in the text. Read Ephesians 4:1-16 together.

- As we continue in our study of the "worthy walk," we are going to receive more and more specific and practical instruction. Ephesians 4:7-16 instructs us in the matter of spiritual gifts...
  - Who has given us our "spiritual" gifts?
  - Why is it important for us to recognize God's grace with regard to our spiritual gifts?
- Looking closely at Ephesians 4:8-10...
  - What insight do you gain about spiritual gifts, and what are these verses referring to?
  - Compare Ephesians 4:8-10 with Philippians 2:4-8.
  - Why does Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection give Him authority to bestow spiritual gifts? See Philippians 2:9-11 for insight.
- According to Ephesians 4:11-13...
  - What different spiritual gifts are listed in verse 11?
  - For what purpose are these particular gifts given?
  - See Romans 12:6-8 and 1 Peter 4:10-11 for additional insight.
- Look at Ephesians 4:13. Based on what we've seen so far in Ephesians, how do "we all attain to the unity of the faith..."
- According to Ephesians 4:14-16, what is the result of being equipped and built up as an individual? What effect does this have on the entire body of Christ?
  - What characterizes the believer who is not growing and maturing in Christ?
  - What causes some believers to remain as "children?"
- Thinking about everything we've learned so far in Ephesians, what advice would you give the Ephesians 4:14 believer?
