
Silent Prayer time: Saturdays 10-11 am. Spend quiet time with the Lord in the open areas of the church grounds. Come and go at your leisure.

Paul Kreitzer John 5:18-47

BIG IDEA of John's Gospel: Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

TODAY'S BIG IDEA: Jesus is equal with God.

In response to the accusations of the religious leaders, Jesus made three significant claims that proved His sonship.

- Jesus claimed to be equal with God 5:18-23
- Jesus claimed to have authority to raise the dead 5:24-29
- Jesus claimed that there were valid witnesses to support his claim to deity 5:30-47

GRACE GROUP QUESTIONS

- 1. Explain the relationship between Jesus and the Father as it is set forth here.
- 2. What is meant when Jesus says he does nothing but "what he sees the Father do?" How did this statement apply to the miracle Jesus had performed in 5:1-17?
- 3. Verse 20 speaks of "greater works than these." What do you think Jesus is referencing?
- 4. What is the implication of verse 23 especially when it is compared to Isaiah 42:8?
- 5. List the witnesses that Jesus appealed to that supported his claim?
- 6. Why was Jesus' testimony alone insufficient to support this claim according to the Law?
- 7. Why was the appeal to Moses damning to the religious leaders?
- 8. Why did the Jews, in spite of all the testimony, refuse to believe? How do their reasons for not believing compare to the reasons for unbelief today?
