Big Idea of John: Jesus Christ is the Son of God

Today's Big Ideas:

- Some Greek-speaking people seek Jesus
- The hour has come and will remain
- A grain (seed) of wheat
- Christ's example of loving the life to come more than the life in this world

GRACE GROUP QUESTIONS

1. What were the Greek-speaking people coming to do? Why do you think they wanted to see Jesus?
2. Why did the Greeks come to Phillip?
3. Do you think the Greeks were Jews or Gentiles? Why?
4. Why do you think the arrival of the Greeks triggered Jesus to say the hour had come for the Son of Man to be glorified?
5. How was Jesus going to be glorified?
6. The word for "the hour has come" means "has arrived and will remain." What is the significance of this?
7. How does a grain (seed) of wheat represent our life here in this world? What did Jesus do with His "seed?"
8. Are we really supposed to hate our life in this world? What do you think Jesus meant by this?
9. What fruit did Jesus bear by dying to Himself and living for His Father?
10. What fruit can believers bear if they die to themselves and follow Jesus?
11. What is the reward for following Jesus? How are we honored by the Father?
