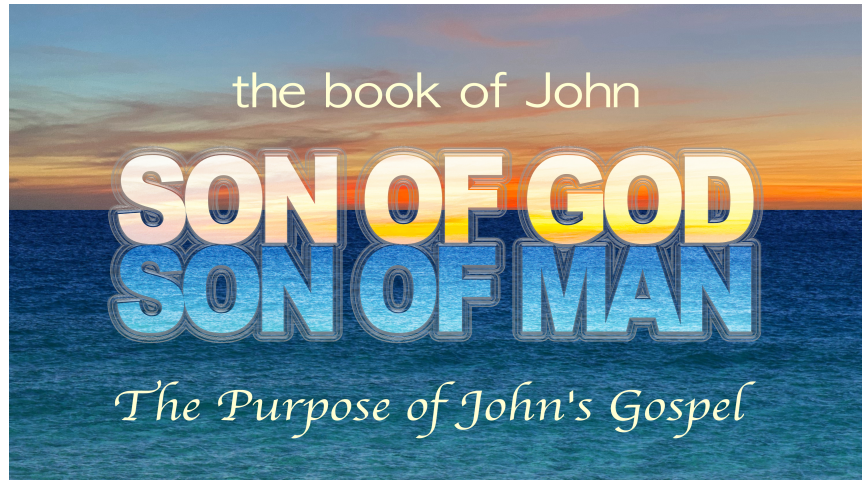

**John Chapters 1-11 Overview**

**Big Idea of John:** Jesus Christ is the Son of God

- Beliefs about Jesus *Then*
- Beliefs about Jesus *Now*
- The Purpose of John's Gospel

## GRACE GROUP QUESTIONS

We are fast approaching the climax of Jesus' ministry - his crucifixion. Remember that the overarching theme of John's Gospel is that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, the promised Messiah. This week, we're going to step back & look at the ground we've covered from the 10,000 foot level.

1. What do John's words in Chapter 1 and John the Baptist's testimony concerning Jesus mean to you?
2. List the miracles that Jesus has performed thus far. What does each of these miracles show Jesus having dominion over?
3. There are those who say that Jesus was merely a great teacher but never claimed to be God. Is this true? If not, in what instances thus far has Jesus clearly proclaimed His deity?
4. What witnesses does Jesus provide that back up His claim to being God?
5. Jesus & Nicodemus discussed being "born again", what type of birth is this? How does it occur? Who ultimately is responsible for it? Give Scriptural justification for your answer
