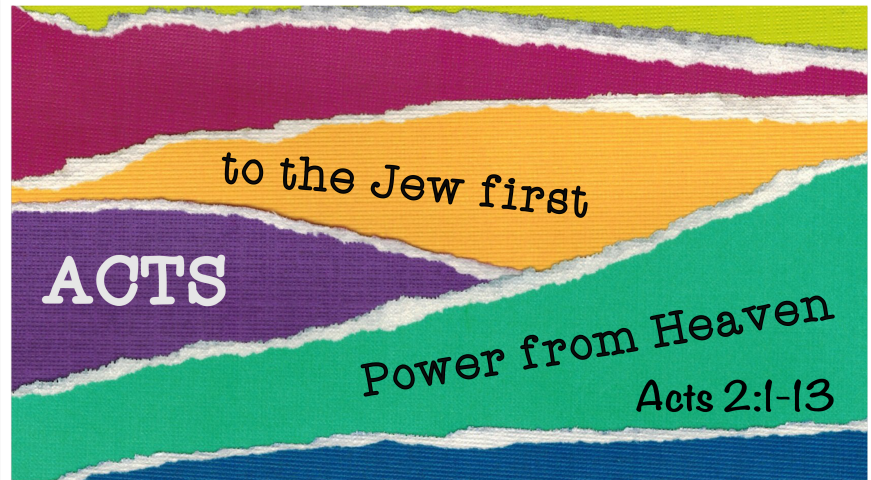
VBS/Summer Bible Camp: Sign up today to volunteer and/or register your children. Bible Camp is June 19-23.

Acts 2:1 - 13

BIG IDEA OF Acts: The Holy Spirit empowered believers to declare the gospel among both Jews and Gentiles.

TODAY'S BIG IDEA: The expected Holy Spirit came with great power.

- The outpouring of the Spirit (2:1-4).
 - Feast of Harvest (Pentecost)
 - Baptism of Holy Spirit
 - Filling of Holy Spirit
- The reaction of the crowd (2:5-13).
 - Confused and amazed
 - Two responses

GRACE GROUP QUESTIONS

1. What was the significance of this Jewish feast? What significance would it play for the Church? What were the 120 doing?
2. What audible and visual signs were evidence of the Spirit's outpouring?
3. What is the meaning of the Baptism of the Spirit and how is it different from the Spirit's filling?
4. Who was present in Jerusalem for the feast?
5. What proof do we have in the text that the tongues were real languages?
6. How did the crowd respond to what they saw and heard?
7. What two responses did the crowd have in vs. 12,13?
