GRACE GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Spend some time in the Biblical text — Read Romans 8 and Galatians 5 together.

“But be filled with the Spirit, addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart, giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.” (Ephesians 5:18-21)

Walking in the Spirit

“Child of God, may you be led by the Holy Spirit! May he lead you to people with whom you need to speak and convict you of areas that aren’t pleasing to the Lord. May he draw you to places of ministry that he has prepared for you and guide you in the decisions of life. And may the active presence of the Spirit in your life be one of the ways that you know that you are a child of God, as our verse says: ‘For all who are being led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.’ (Rom. 8:14).”

So, how do you live life in the Spirit?

1. Walk in the Spirit.
2. Set your mind on the things of the Spirit.
3. Put to death the deeds of the body by the Spirit.
4. Be led by the Spirit.

Be led by the Spirit

1. How does the Holy Spirit lead us as we move through life? What does the leading of the Spirit include?
2. How important is knowing Scripture in the discussion of the leading of the Spirit?
3. Why is it difficult to describe to others how the Holy Spirit leads?
4. Do you agree that it is sometimes easier to see the guidance of the Holy Spirit after the fact than before? Can you think of examples from your own experience?

Spend some time sharing and praying together.

- Pray for each other. Pray for the unity of our church family.
- Pray that we would individually and corporately experience more and more of the Holy Spirit working in and through our lives.
- Pray that we would increasingly tap into the enabling power that we have access to with the Spirit living in us.
