

GRACE GROUP QUESTIONS

- 1. What is the meaning of the phrase "Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon you to test you" in 1 Peter 4:12?
- 2. How does the knowledge that suffering is a part of the Christian life affect our attitude towards trials and tribulations?
- 3. In verse 14, what does it mean to "rejoice" insofar as you share Christ's sufferings?
- 4. What are some practical ways we can "glorify God" in the midst of suffering?
- 5. How can we discern whether our suffering is a result of our own wrongdoing or simply a consequence of living in a fallen world?
- 6. What is the significance of the phrase "let those who suffer according to God's will entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good" in verse 19?
- 7. In what ways does suffering for the sake of Christ serve to purify and refine our faith?
- 8. How can we comfort and support other believers who are going through difficult times?
- 9. What does it mean to suffer as a Christian, and how does this differ from other types of suffering?
- 10. How can we cultivate a mindset that is prepared to face trials and suffering with faith and perseverance?
