Manny Martinez - Elder 2 Peter 3:1-18

Todays' Big Idea: Remember, our Lord Returns!

Peter writes to encourage those being persecuted. He reminds them that Jesus will return.

•Be mindful of God's Word and promises - Remember

•Do not be deceived by scoffers - Be Alert

•Live holy and godly lives in anticipation of the day of God's coming - Live holy lives and wait

GRACE GROUP QUESTIONS

Read the passage 2 Peter 3 pick out the main topics that stand out to you and share them:

- 1. In 2 Peter 3:8, it is mentioned that "one day is like a thousand years" to God. How does this concept align with Psalms 90:4, which states that "a thousand years in your sight are like a day that has just gone by"?
- 2. According to 2 Peter 3:10, the heavens and earth will be destroyed with fire on the day of the Lord. How does this relate to Revelation 21:1, where a new heaven and a new earth are described?
- 3. In 2 Peter 3:9, it is mentioned that the Lord is patient, not wanting anyone to perish but everyone to come to repentance. How does this concept connect with 1 Timothy 2:4, which speaks about God's desire for all people to be saved and come to a knowledge of the truth?
- 4. In 2 Peter 3:11, Peter emphasizes the importance of holy and godly lives as we wait for the day of the Lord. How does this align with Matthew 24:44, where Jesus instructs His followers to be ready and prepared for His return?
- 5. In 2 Peter 3:14, Peter encourages his readers to make every effort to be found spotless, blameless, and at peace with God. How does this connect with Philippians 2:15, which urges believers to shine like stars in a crooked and depraved generation?
- 6. 2 Peter 3:15 mentions that Paul's letters contain wisdom given to him by God. How does this affirmation relate to 2 Timothy 3:16, which states that all Scripture is God-breathed and useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness?
- 7. Peter warns about the coming judgment and destruction of the ungodly in 2 Peter 3:7. How does this align with Jude 1:14-15, which references the judgment that will come upon all who are ungodly?
- 8. According to 2 Peter 3:5, Peter refers to the fact that the heavens existed long ago and the earth was formed out of water and by water. How does this concept connect with Genesis 1:6-7, where the waters above and below the heavens are mentioned during the creation account?
- 9. In 2 Peter 3:3-4, Peter speaks about scoffers who will come in the last days, questioning the promise of Christ's return. How does this align with 1 Thessalonians 5:2-3, which speaks of the sudden destruction that will come upon the world when people say, "Peace and safety"?
- 10. 2 Peter 3:18 encourages believers to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. How does this connect with Ephesians 4:15, which speaks about growing in every way into Christ, the head of the body?
