The Tithe in the Old Testament

"Theocrafic Tax"

The 3 tithes in the Mosaic Law1

1st tithe - 1/10 of all

(called "the Lord's tithe" and "the storehouse tithe")

Focus: given to the Levites for their service in the tabernacle/temple
(Leviticus 27:30-33; Numbers 18:21-32)

2nd tithe - 1/10 of remaining 9/10

(called "the Israelites' tithe")

Focus: set apart and spent on the food and drink of a sacred meal in Jerusalem "in the presence of the Lord your God"

(Deuteronomy 12:5-19; 14:22-27)

[those living too far from Jerusalem to bring animals, grain, wine, and oil for the meal could exchange the value of the meal's ingredients for money to purchase the meal in Jerusalem]

3rd tithe - An additional tithe every 3rd year

(or 1/10 of the remaining balance of 8/10 every 3rd year)
(a "charity or benevolence tithe")

Focus: for the Levites, aliens, orphans, and widows in one's local community because they have no inheritance in the land (Deuteronomy 14:28-29)

If there <u>are 2 tithes</u>, the total "tithe" = <u>19%</u> per year!

If there are 3 tithes, the total "tithe" = approximately 22% per year!

¹ There is no clear consensus among Old Testament scholars about whether there were three different tithes in Israel or whether the three sets of instructions about tithing were to bring out three different facets of the one tithe. To this author it is hard to correlate the three very different foci and emphases of the three sets of instructions with only one tithe. Additionally, given the "theocratic tax" dimension of the tithes, it seems far more likely that 19-22% of each Israelite family's income would be needed to keep the theocratic infrastructure going rather than 10%.
