Ephesians 6:10-20 (week of Feb 2, 2020)

Spend some time catching up and talking story.

Spend some time in the text — Read Ephesians 6:10-20 together.

Review:

- What are the difficulties in walking in our relationships in the ways that Paul instructs us to in Ephesians 5:21-6:9?
- Do you think there is a link to the following passage on spiritual warfare (6:10-20)?

A Biblical view of Satan:

- The name Satan comes from a Hebrew word that means adversary.
- Old Testament prophets Ezekiel and Isaiah both give us key information about Satan and his cosmic rebellion by first critiquing a human leader gone bad and then moving on to Satan himself:
 - Ezekiel 28 make observations of what we learn of Satan
 - Isaiah 14 make observation of what we learn of Satan

Making sense of our adversary:

- What images do you associate with Satan or the devil?
 - List 5 descriptors of the devil that readily come to mind.
 - Are these images spurred on by Scripture or pop culture?
- While most of the global church takes Satan seriously, the church in the West struggles to embrace the reality of spiritual battle.
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 - When you think through the last year, how many sermons did you hear about Satan or spiritual battle?
 - Why does the uncomfortable idea of spiritual battle cause Western Christians to shy away from the reality of Satan?
- What keeps you, in your relationships, from embracing the reality of spiritual battle?
 - How often do you or your friends discuss Satan or the possibility of spiritual oppression?
 - Why would Satan care about our relationships?

Spend some time sharing and praying together.

- Pray through Ephesians 5:1-6:9. Pray that the Lord will give us the strength and power to obey His words to us. Pray specifically for situations in our lives that require a submissive spirit.
- Thank God for giving us His Spirit to guide us and empower us.
- Pray that we will stand, in God's power, and resist in the "evil day."
