Lodging at Camp Sugar Pine

Preference will be given to persons who rented cabins the previous year, if reservation is postmarked by May 1, 2022

- ◆ 12 Cabins (restroom nearby), bunk beds. \$ 775.00
- ◆ 8 Timber Mountain Cabin. \$ 600.00
(restroom nearby), bunk beds.

Camp Sugar Pine DOES NOT allow any hot plates or BBQ's in or around cabins!

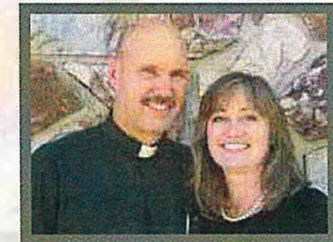
Dr. Tim Green
