April 19th – God Will Put Your Faith to the Test

"And they were left, that He might test Israel by them, to know whether they would obey the commandments of the Lord, which He had commanded their fathers by the hand of Moses."

(Judges 3:4)

All of us have been put to the test. In my lifetime, I've been blessed to graduate high school, college, and seminary (twice). If I had a \$20 bill for every test I've taken I'd be a wealthy man by now! Have you ever wondered why a teacher would administer a test? Just to punish the class? Because the school board says so? Of course not. A teacher issues a test is to gauge the student's understanding of the subject matter. A test is designed to separate those who know from those who don't.
