August 17th – The Mere Edges of His Ways

"Indeed these are the mere edges of His ways, and how small a whisper we hear of Him! But the thunder of His power who can understand?"

(Job 26:14)

As Job was reflecting on all his sorrow, he didn't neglect to remember the amazing power of God. In Job 26, he recounted God's power in creation. Among other things he said, "He stretches out the north over empty space; He hangs the earth on nothing. He binds up the water in His thick clouds" (Job 26:7-8). The fact is that God created everything out of nothing, and even now the whole of creation is being held together by His power. Despite what evolutionists say, without God there is no creation!
