



## Opening *(all play)*

1. Have you ever given up on something quickly? (sports team, performance arts, relationship, investment, etc...)  
*-Why'd you give up?*

## Text *(Different participants read through each text)*

2. Daniel 3:1 — *Do you remember the height of this statue in feet?*
3. Daniel 3:25 — *Who was the fourth person in the furnace?*

## Short Answer

4. Who was Shadrach, Meshach & Abednego?
5. How old do most think Shadrach, Meshach & Abednego were in this story?
6. Why did Nebuchadnezzar's security die?
7. Nebuchadnezzar was constantly reminded of the legitimacy of God. Why do you think he kept forgetting and acting as though he were a god?

## Discussion

8. Believers tend to gravitate toward either combatting culture or blending in. Which is it for you and why?
9. Scott asked, do you follow Jesus or are you hoping Jesus will follow you. What does that mean?  
*-What area of your life are you hoping Jesus follows you instead of you following Jesus?*
10. "God is either your God no matter what, or he isn't really your God at all." Are you currently going through something that is testing your commitment to God? (temptation, trials, etc...)
