## ὑπηρέτης. Hupērētēs,

Anyone who serves with their hands, rendering service, who helps, aids another in any work, ministers, attendants of a king, an assistant, a preacher of the gospel.

- Waiter
- Housekeeper
- Cook
- Secretary
- Administrative Assistant

1 Corinthians 4:<sup>1</sup> Think of us as **servants of Christ** who have been given the work of explaining God's mysterious ways. And since our first duty is to be faithful to the one we work for, CEV

## θεράπων, therápōn,

An attendant and servant of God, of Moses discharging the duties committed to him by God.

Hebrews 3:<sup>4</sup> For [of course] every house is built *and* furnished by someone, but the Builder of all things *and* the Furnisher [of the entire equipment of all things] is God. <sup>5</sup> And **Moses** certainly was faithful in the **administration** of all God's house [but it was only] **as a ministering servant**. [In his entire ministry he was but] a testimony to the things which were to be spoken [the revelations to be given afterward in Christ]. AMPC

## δουλόω, doulóō,

- **Literally:** to make a slave of someone, to be reduced to bondage.
- **Metaphorically:** to give myself wholly to one's needs and service, to make myself a bondman to him.

Romans 6:<sup>18</sup> Now that you have been set free from sin, you have become **servants/slaves of righteousness**. CEB

Romans 6:<sup>22</sup> But now that you have been set free from sin and become **servants/slaves to God**, you have the consequence of a holy life, and the outcome is eternal life. CEB

1 Corinthians 9:<sup>19</sup> I am a free man, nobody's slave; **but I make myself everybody's servant/slave** in order to win as many people as possible. NIV

## δοῦλος, doûlos,

- **Literally:** a slave, bondman, a servant, attendant.
- **Metaphorically:** one who give himself up to another's whose service is used by Christ in extending and advancing his cause among men. Devoted to another to the disregard of one's own interests.

Matthew 25:<sup>21</sup> His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful **servant**: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

Philippians 2:<sup>7</sup> But stripped Himself [of all privileges and rightful dignity], so as to assume the guise of a **servant (slave)**, in that He became like men *and* was born a human being. AMPC
