Being on Mission Requires a Vision

ὄραμα - hórama

- That which is seen. A spectacle, something exhibited, shown or displayed.
- Something that God reveals.
- In a vision God can speak or explain the vision and interact with the person.
- Acts 9:¹⁰ In Damascus there was a disciple named Ananias. The Lord called to him in a vision, "Ananias!" "Yes, Lord," he answered.
- Other scriptures where horama is used.
Matthew 17:9; Acts 7:31; 9:10; 10:3; 10:17; 10:19; 11:5; 12:9; 16:10; 18:9

ὄρασις - hórasis

- The act of seeing, of the senses given to man to ability to see, the eyes.
- Spiritual Symbolism:
- An appearance, something the person sees, the ability given and enabled by God (Holy Spirit) in a Supernatural Experience or a dream.

Acts 2:¹⁷ "In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams.

Revelation 9:17; 4:13

ὄπτασία - optasía

- to give of oneself to be able to see, perceive and to know it is something heavenly that you are seeing.
- Acts 26: 19 "So, King Agrippa, I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision

God uses visions to provide direction, instruction and correction.

- Something you see and God Confirms.
- Something the Holy Spirit shows you.
- What is the greatest need you see?
- Does it move you as it did Nehemiah?
- Do you have a 'plan' how to meet that need?
- Goals in Life,
- Dreams (Bucket List)
- Calling, Ministry, Serving

The Enemy Factor

Nehemiah 4:1 **When Sanballat heard** that we were rebuilding the wall, he **became angry** and was greatly incensed. **He ridiculed the Jews,**

- The enemy is aware of you & your MISSION
- Job "Have you seen my son Job" (Job 1:6-12)
- Could it be that God has been bragging about you and your MISSION?

- Your MISSION will anger your enemies
- There is no such thing as a friendly enemy

Nehemiah 4:2 and in the presence of his associates and the army of Samaria, he said, "What are those feeble Jews doing? Will they restore their wall? Will they offer sacrifices? Will they finish in a day? Can they bring the stones back to life from those heaps of rubble—burned as they are?"³ Tobiah the Ammonite, who was at his side, said, "What they are building—even a fox climbing up on it would break down their wall of stones!"

- The enemy will instigate doubt,
- The enemy will plant seeds of doubt, confusion, uncertainty.

"Any time the enemy attacks you with his anger, ridicule, doubt or fear...it's because your enemy fears who you will become and what you can do to defeat him in the lives of others."
