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Family Prayer Guide June 22-27

“For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save the lost.” - Luke 19:10

Loving the Lost: The Kurtop people live in isolated areas in northern Bhutan. The nation's royal family has a special connection to the Kurtop people, tracing their ancestry back to one of these remote villages. The Kurtop follow Tibetan Buddhism, which influences all aspects of their lives. Most families consider it an honor to send their young sons to a monastery for a time. Most become monks for the spiritual reasons as well as the physical benefits of provided food, education, and lodging.

MONDAY-

- Pray through Psalm 22, 52, 82, 112, 142
- Pray the Kurtop will hear the gospel and follow Jesus, who is calling them “out of darkness into his marvelous light” (1 Peter 2:9).
- **Pray for the Richmond Community: East-side of Richmond**

TUESDAY-

- Pray through a Psalm 23, 53, 83, 113, 143
- CP Story - Chris and Rhonda Richard (Buenos Aires)
 - What started as a simple English club in Buenos Aires quickly became something more. IMB missionaries Chris and Rhonda Richard, sent from Hebron Baptist Church in Kentucky, taught language and culture—but also shared the gospel using the “Three Circles” evangelism tool.
