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Family Prayer Guide Sept 29 - Oct 4

"Above all, be strong and very courageous to observe carefully the whole instruction my servant Moses commanded you, Do not turn from it to the right or the left, so that you will have success wherever you go." - Joshua 1:7

- **Balkan Romani of Latvia:**
 - *Balkan Romani in Latvia value family, show respect to others, and discourage harmful and selfish behaviors in their communities. They want to live good lives, but their circumstances are often challenging. The Balkan Romani live at a high risk of poverty. Around 35% of their households earn the equivalent of less than \$65 USD per month. The Balkan Romani often suffer from discrimination, and they don't have many opportunities for good jobs. They speak Baltic Romani and aren't a part of any organized religion. The social divide and language barrier make it difficult for Latvian believers to reach this people group with the good news of abundant life in Jesus Christ.*

MONDAY-

- Pray through Psalm 29, 59, 89, 119, 149
- Prayer: Pray for the Balkan Romani of Latvia to hear the good news that they are beloved by God, and ask that they receive salvation.

TUESDAY-

- Pray through a Psalm 30, 60, 90, 120, 150
- CP Story - David and Elany Clark (Roseville, Michigan)
 - Pray for the Hippses and those involved with the ELM Pregnancy Center, asking for unity, wisdom, and love as they serve women in need.

WEDNESDAY - Prayer Night, 6 - 7p

- Pray through a Psalm 1, 31, 61, 91, 121
- From IMB Prayer Points: Dhaka, Bangladesh
 - Workers from areas surrounding Bangladesh are drawn to the capitol city, Dhaka, hoping for a better life. Pray that the Holy Spirit will draw them to have abundant life in Jesus (John 10:10) and make a way for them to hear the gospel.

THURSDAY -

- Pray through Psalm 2, 32, 62, 92, 122
- Chile, Pray for the Frealy family
 - Pray for Lord to open a door to share the Gospel more completely and for Him to prepare the students' hearts to receive the message... These precious kids are biblically illiterate, and many of them are already neck-deep in homosexual and trans lifestyle, even in their teen years...
