A believer from another country began to research the Beni Shangul and visit their small, isolated farming villages. He discovered more than a dozen Beni Shangul believers! In 2023, despite major challenges with communication and transportation, these Beni Shangul believers gathered in a large city to learn how to share their faith. Now, Beni Shangul believers are growing in discipleship and starting small groups where there are no churches.
