Loving the Lost: Central Asian People

- Population: 389 million
- People Groups: 404
- Die without Christ: 8,279/day
- Unreached People Groups: 163
- Most believers in Central Asia are first-generation believers, with a small number having known Jesus for more than 30yrs.

MONDAY-

- Pray through Psalm 20, 50, 80, 110, 140
- Praise the Lord for all He has done in Robert's life and in this people group! Pray that the gospel will continue to spread among them and beyond, reaching new communities and transforming more lives.
- **Pray for the Richmond Community: East-side of Richmond**

TUESDAY-

- Pray through a Psalm 21, 51, 81, 111, 141
- Pray for the Adcock family
- **CP Story** - Leanne Stack (Eastern Europe)
 - Through oral storytelling, Stack shares biblical accounts of suffering—stories of Daniel in exile, Elijah on the run, and Jesus calming the storm. The women act out and discuss these narratives, connecting deeply with the emotions of loss, fear, and distress they know all too well.
- **Pray for the Richmond Community: North Richmond**

WEDNESDAY -

- Pray through a Psalm 22, 52, 82, 112, 142

From IMB Prayer Points: Sub-Saharan African Peoples - In northeast Burkina Faso, the Songhai endure harsh landscape, deep Islamic tradition, and lingering spiritual beliefs that keep many from knowing Jesus. Pray for softened hearts and for Burkina believers to bravely carry the gospel where international workers cannot.
