Family Prayer Guide Jan 12-17

"Above all, be strong and very courageous to observe carefully the whole instruction my servant Moses commanded you, Do not turn from it to the right or the left, so that you will have success wherever you go." - Joshua 1:7

Loving the Lost: The Wolof (WAW-lawf) are renowned for their culture and language. Known as skilled fishermen, dancers, and wrestlers, they have a rich cultural heritage. They primarily cultivate peanuts or work as merchants. Church-planting efforts are underway among the Wolof in Senegal, but in Mauritania, where they are a minority group, there is no known effort to reach them with the gospel. The Wolof are Muslim with deep animistic roots, believing a verse from the Quran can serve as a curse or blessing. A marabout, or Muslim spiritual leader, holds significant authority in their community.

Family Prayer Guide Jan 12-17

- Loving the Lost: Wasi (wah-SEE), also known as the Alagwa (ah-LAH-gwah) people, are found only in north-central Tanzania. They number around 60,000 people and live in 15 villages on a rocky hill terrain. The Wasi are farmers, growing maize and millet, and they work together to meet community-wide needs. They practice folk Islam, blending Islamic practices and beliefs with those of traditional African religions. The Wasi are very reserved and don't easily allow outsiders to live among them. Some Bible portions, gospel recordings, and the JESUS film are available in their language. But they have yet to hear the good news of Jesus Christ, and they have no missionary presence among them.
