- The Khunsari (Khan-sar-ee) people follow Isalm and live mainly near Esfahan, Iran. Iranian tourists are drawn to the region for its stunning mountains and springs. Most Khunsari earn their livelihood through farming and herding, yet rural life has its challenges in Iran. They struggle to get access to healthcare and education. And Iran's ongoing economic crisis only makes their high unemployment rates worse. Many Khunsari migrate to cities, hoping for better opportunities. With all the problems the Khunsari face, their greatest problem is lostness. There are no Bible resources in their primary language or any known believers among them to share the solution to lostness-the gospel.
