Day 7: Spiritual Empowerment ~ Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Today, we are addressing the topic of the baptism of the Holy Spirit. This is a controversial topic for some and divides the evangelical world. There are some that believe the baptism of the Spirit was only for the day of Pentecost and others, like myself, who believe it remains vital for today. Individuals like me are called Pentecostals.

Jesus instructed the disciples to return to Jerusalem and wait for the power from on high (Luke 24:49). This power is the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit comes at Pentecost in Acts 2:1-4, "When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. ² Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. ⁴ All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them." What a powerful display of the glory of God and the Spirit which was sent to believers in place of Christ to walk daily with them as they demonstrated the Gospel to the known world.

There are additional scriptures that point out the baptizing of the Spirit and speaking in tongues. In your worksheet on the next page, you will be encouraged to read those scriptures.

There are multiple purposes to be filled with the Spirit. We are empowered to share Jesus with the world. Boldness and courage erupt within us as the Spirit drives us to tell people about the Savior of the world.

The filling of the Spirit also transforms our lives and we go from glory to glory. The purpose for today though is to recognize the importance and desire to be baptized with more of Him.

Day 7 Worksheet
