THIS WEEK: ABRAHAM



LATER TODAY:

What did you learn this morning?:

When Abraham traveled to Egypt, he lied and told the Pharaoh that his wife Sarah was actually his sister. Years later, Abraham repeated the same FAIL when he lied to Abimelek. Despite his repeated failure, God chose Abraham to be the father of the nation of Israel. Even though we may have made lots of mistakes or the same mistake over and over like Abraham, God will still forgive us when we admit our sins and our need to be saved. Genesis 12:10-20, Abram in Egypt, Genesis 20:1-13, Abraham and Abimelek



MANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Watch some fail videos with your kids this week, or some America's Funniest Videos. (Note: you may want to screen videos first, as some fail channels on YouTube have content not appropriate for children.) Ask your kids to tell you what they learned about Abraham's fails and how God still used Abraham's life to do something good.



AT DINNER:

- Can God use us to do good things, even when we fail Him?

TO WHAT'S THE DEAL?:

What you need to know: Fail videos remind us that we're all human. They remind us that no one's perfect. No one can live a perfect life, but God will forgive our sins and use us to do His will. Ask God to use you in spite of your "fails" this week.
