PURPOSE & PROTECTION Titus 1:1-9 February 20, 2022 Andrew Boone

BIG IDEA:

As Christians, we work from our identity and purpose as we represent Christ in everything we do.

STUDY GUIDE QUESTIONS

- Identity is who we ARE made to be or declared to be. Paul mentions "servant" and "apostle" as part of his identity in Titus 1:1. What passages of scripture give us a picture of our identity? For example, Galatians 3:26 says "So in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith." Here we learn that part of our identity is that we are children of God.
- Purpose is what we are made to DO. Paul mentions "preaching" and "furthering faith" as part of his purpose in Titus 1:2-3. What passages of scripture give us a picture of the purpose for all believers? For example, 2 Corinthians 5:18-19 says "All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation." Here we learn that part of our purpose is to be agents of reconciliation to a world estranged from God.
- Do you agree or disagree with the following statement, and why? Statement: Any specific purpose given to an individual believer must fit underneath and within the Great Commission and Greatest Commandments?
- Do you have a specific purpose within the body of Christ that you believe has been given to you?
- How are church leaders like company leaders (CEO, president, manager, etc.)? How are church leaders unlike company leaders?
- Why are so many elements of a person's personal life included in the list of qualifications for church leadership?
- When you evaluate your life through the lens of being an ambassador for Christ everywhere you go, how are you doing? What areas are excelling? What areas are struggling?
