

## WEEK 13: REDEEMED IS REDEEMED

### SCRIPTURE GUIDE

1 Corinthians 7:17-24

### MAIN FOCUS

Rarely do we find ourselves in the absolute perfect situations in this life. There are times when we have thoughts of needing just a little bit more of one thing, or a little less of another. We have seasons of just feeling stuck in a situation or environment we just want out of. Steve leads us through the idea that we aren't stuck. Not only are we not stuck, but that we are the exact right person for the circumstance.

The New Covenant is a focus on the heart. Jesus teaches that what comes out of the mouth proceeds from the heart, and this defiles a person. The world puts pressure on outward appearance, but God examines the heart. God has called us as He found us, and now there is no distinction for those who are in Christ.

God recognizes our circumstances; He has assigned us our lives. We belong to Him and we've been bought with a price. The question becomes, what are we doing with the life we have been called to?
