ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Today is a happy day! Do you know why it's a happy day? Because God loves us so much God gave us Jesus!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, knowing You makes every day a happy day! Thank You for _____. And thank You that Jesus is alive! We love You!"



Drive Time

While on the go, take turns saying this sentence: "Thank You, God, for _____." End by saying: "Thank You, God, for Jesus!"



Bath Time

Add body wash and a cup to bath time. Smell the body wash and talk about how good it smells. Put a little body wash in the cup with some water. Pour the water on your child's feet. Say: "Mary poured perfume on Jesus' feet and wiped them with her hair to show Jesus she was thankful for Him."
