When we think about how much Jesus has forgiven us, it's easier to forgive other people. Write a letter to Jesus thanking Him for His incredible love and forgiveness.



BIBLE BASIS: Matthew 18:21-35


KEY VERSE: "Forgive one another if you are holding something against someone. Forgive, just as the Lord forgave you." Colossians 3:13b (NIRV)
