“The hotel is almost at the hearts of town, overlooking the tiny slum city.... The first night we arrived, we were looking out at the mismatched tin roofs that have been barely secured and are rusted with time.”

“The number of roofs and their subsequent different colors almost threatened a beautiful scene. People were saying ‘¡qué chevere! [how cool],’ I think unable to comprehend that these tin roofs are poverty.”

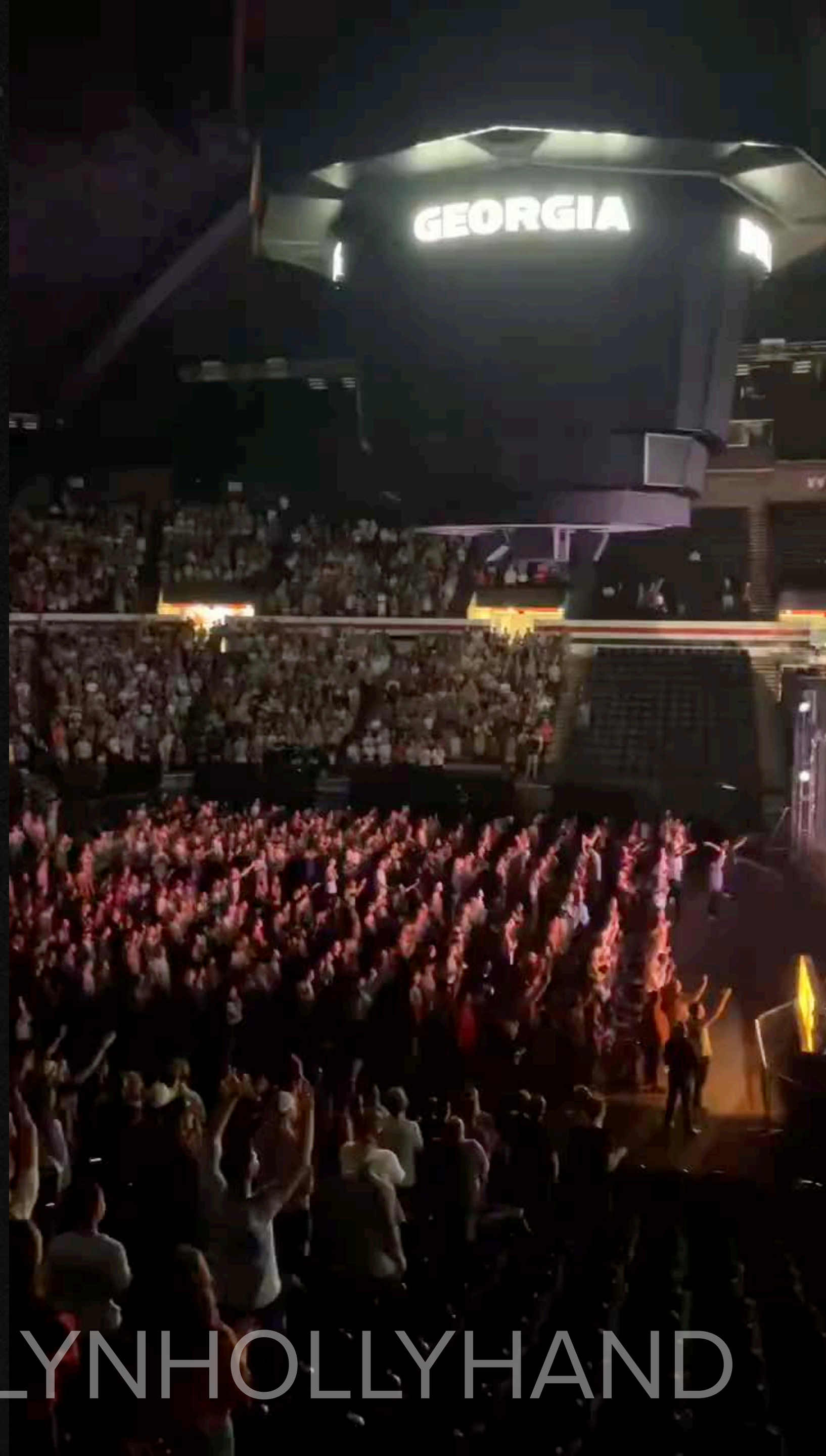

“Each person living next to the trash, under the tin roof is a story. Dios [God] died for all these tin roofs. It’s critical to remember this. Each roof is a human muy importante a Dios, entonces importante a mi [very important to God, therefore important to me].”

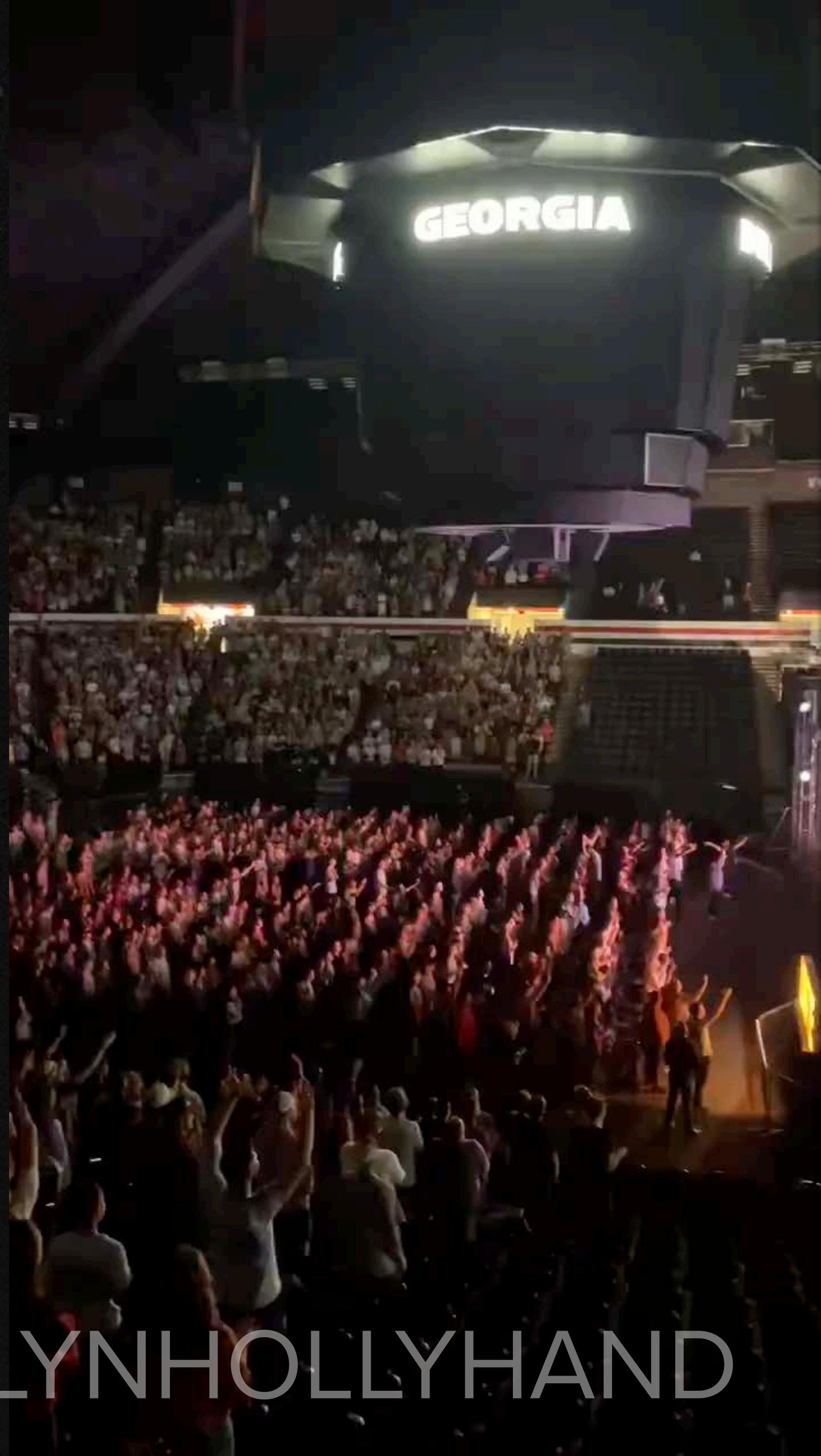
