

1. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND — ANSWER KEY

1. The days of Noah were filled with extreme **wickedness** and **corruption**.
2. God saw that every inclination of the human heart was **evil** all the time.
3. The earth was full of **violence**.
4. Noah stood **alone** as a preacher of righteousness.
5. Noah did not earn God's favor—he **found** it.

2. HEBREWS 11:7 — A MODEL OF FAITH

1. Hebrews 11:7 describes Noah's faith expressed in three key behaviors:
 - o He listened to God's **warning**
 - o He trusted what he could not **see**
 - o He obeyed with **holy** fear

3. IMPORTANT GREEK WORD STUDY — ANSWER KEY

A. “Warned” — **chrēmatistheis**

- “To be **divinely** instructed” or **supernaturally** warned by God.

B. “Things not yet seen” — **mēdepō blepomenōn**

- “Nothing **visible**; no physical **evidence**.”

C. “In **holy** fear” — **eulabeitheis**

- “Reverent **awe** that leads to careful **obedience**.”

D. “Built” — **kateskeuasen**

- “To build with **skill**, to prepare **thoroughly**.”

E. “Condemned the world” — **katekrinen**

- “To judge by **contrast**, to expose by **comparison**.”

F. “Heir of righteousness” — **klēronomos dikaiosynēs**

- “To receive **righteousness** by **faith**.”

4. NOAH'S FAITH IN ACTION — ANSWER KEY

1. Noah responded to **divine** revelation.
2. Noah believed the **unseen** things he could not see.
3. Noah obeyed with **reverent** awe.
4. Noah built with **excellence** and precision.
5. Noah's obedience exposed the world's **unbelief**.
6. Noah became an heir of **righteousness** through faith.

5. MODERN DIMENSIONS OF THE ARK — ANSWER KEY

1. The ark measured **450 ft long, 75 ft wide, and 45 ft high**.
2. In cubits: **300 cubits long, 50 cubits wide, 30 cubits high**.
3. The ark was about the length of **1.5** football fields.
4. The ark was shaped more like a **barge** than a boat.
5. Building the ark required decades of **faith, obedience, and endurance**.
