- did not **know** where he was going
- lived like a **stranger**
- dwelling in **tents**
- looked forward to the **city**
- foundations built by **God**

Part 4: Faith That Obeys (v. 8)

- land he would later **receive**
- stepped out in **faith**
- Genesis 12:1 — God would **show** him
- Genesis 12:4 — Abram **went**

Part 5: Faith That Lives as a Pilgrim (v. 9)

- made his home like a **stranger**
- lived in **tents**
- believers as **foreigners** and exiles
- 1 Peter 2:11 — believers are **foreigners** and exiles
- Philippians 3:20 — our **citizenship** is in heaven

- city with **foundations**
- architect and builder is **God**
- Revelation 21:2 — Holy **City** comes down from heaven
- John 14:2–3 — Jesus prepares a **place** for His followers
