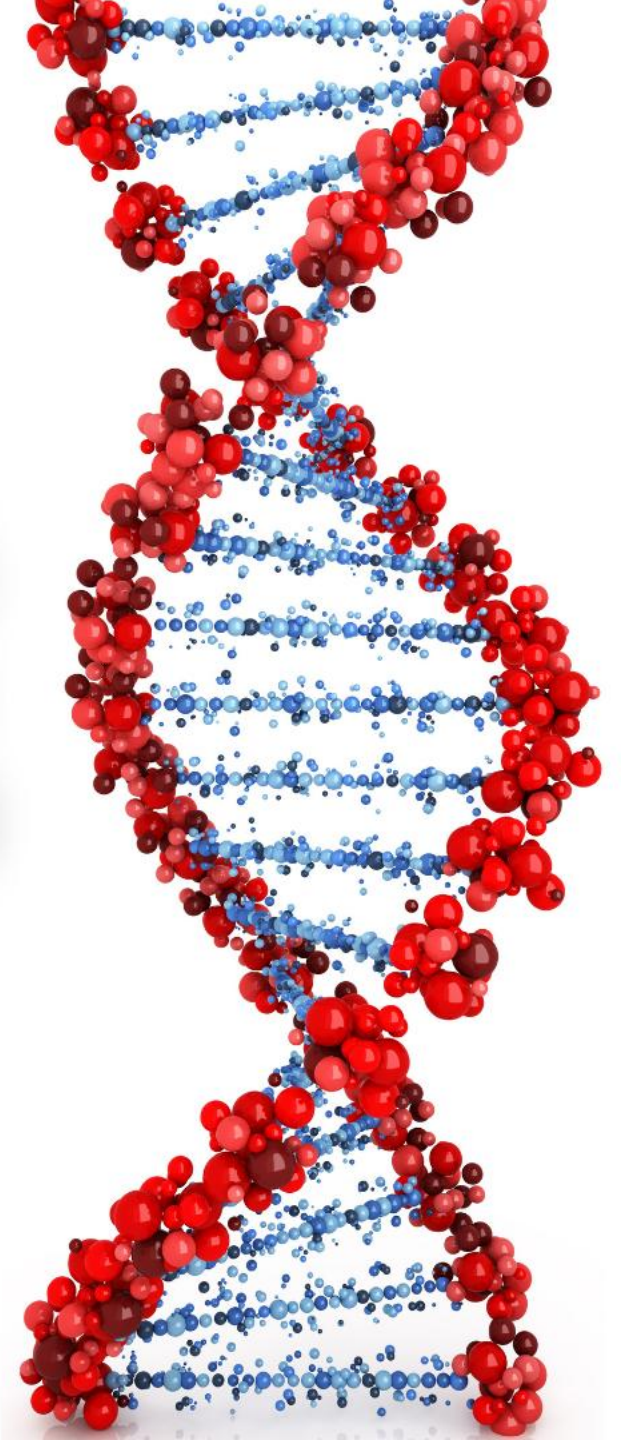

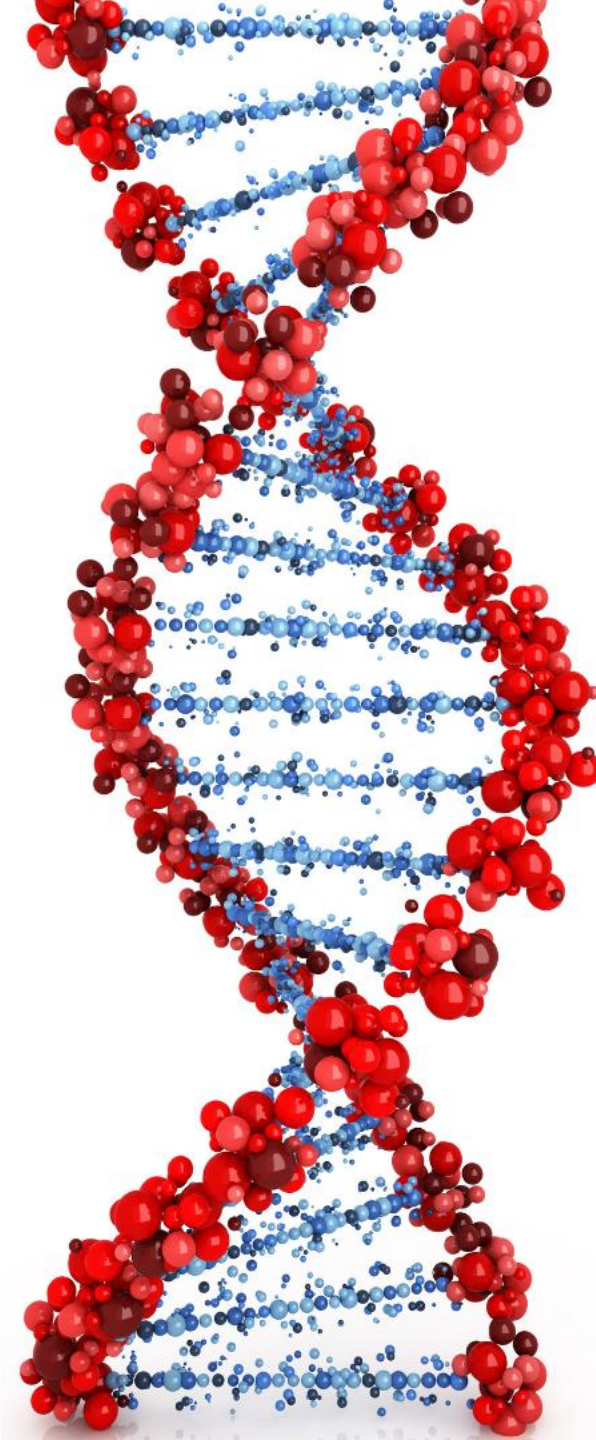

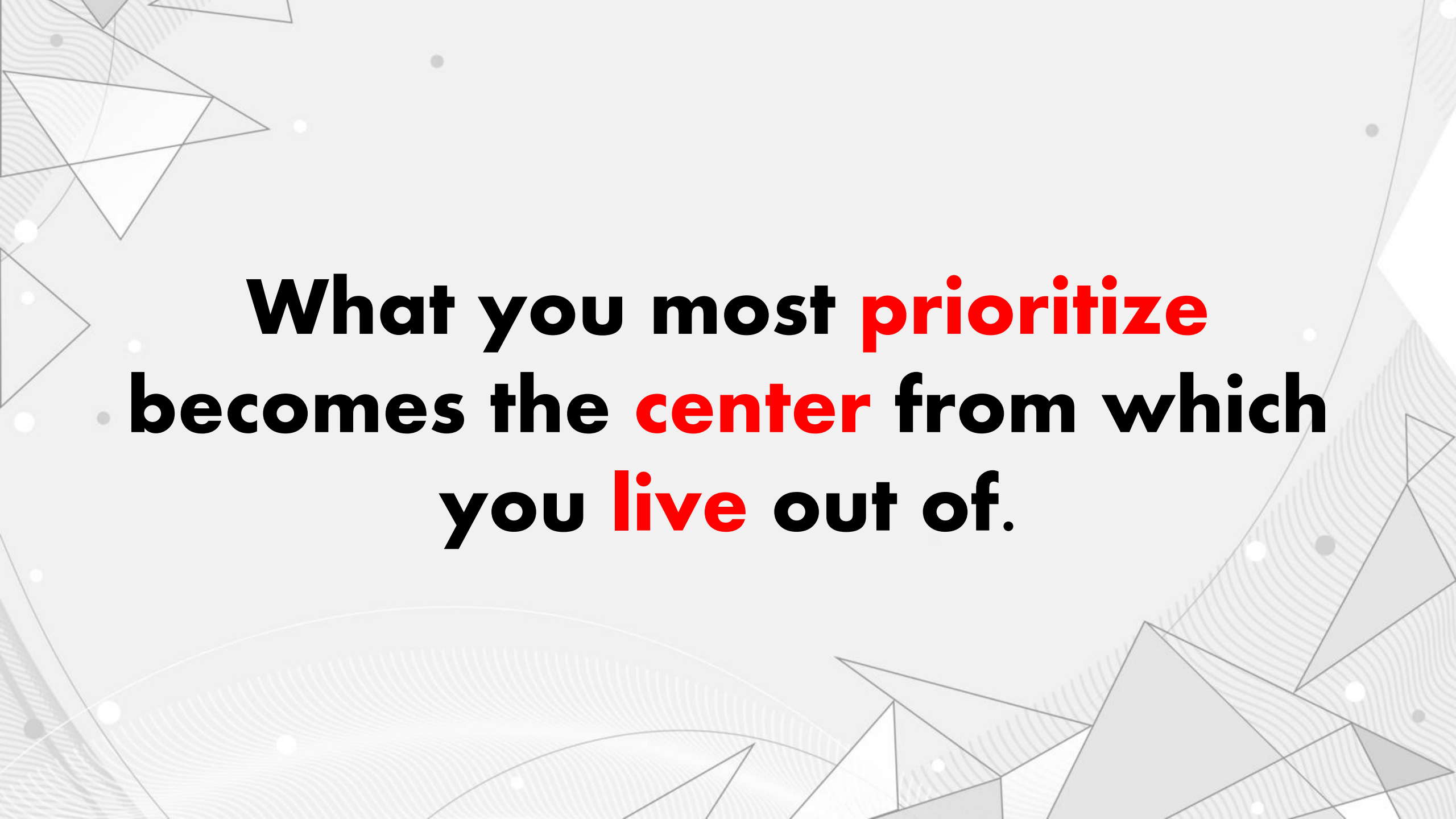

Acts 2:42–47.

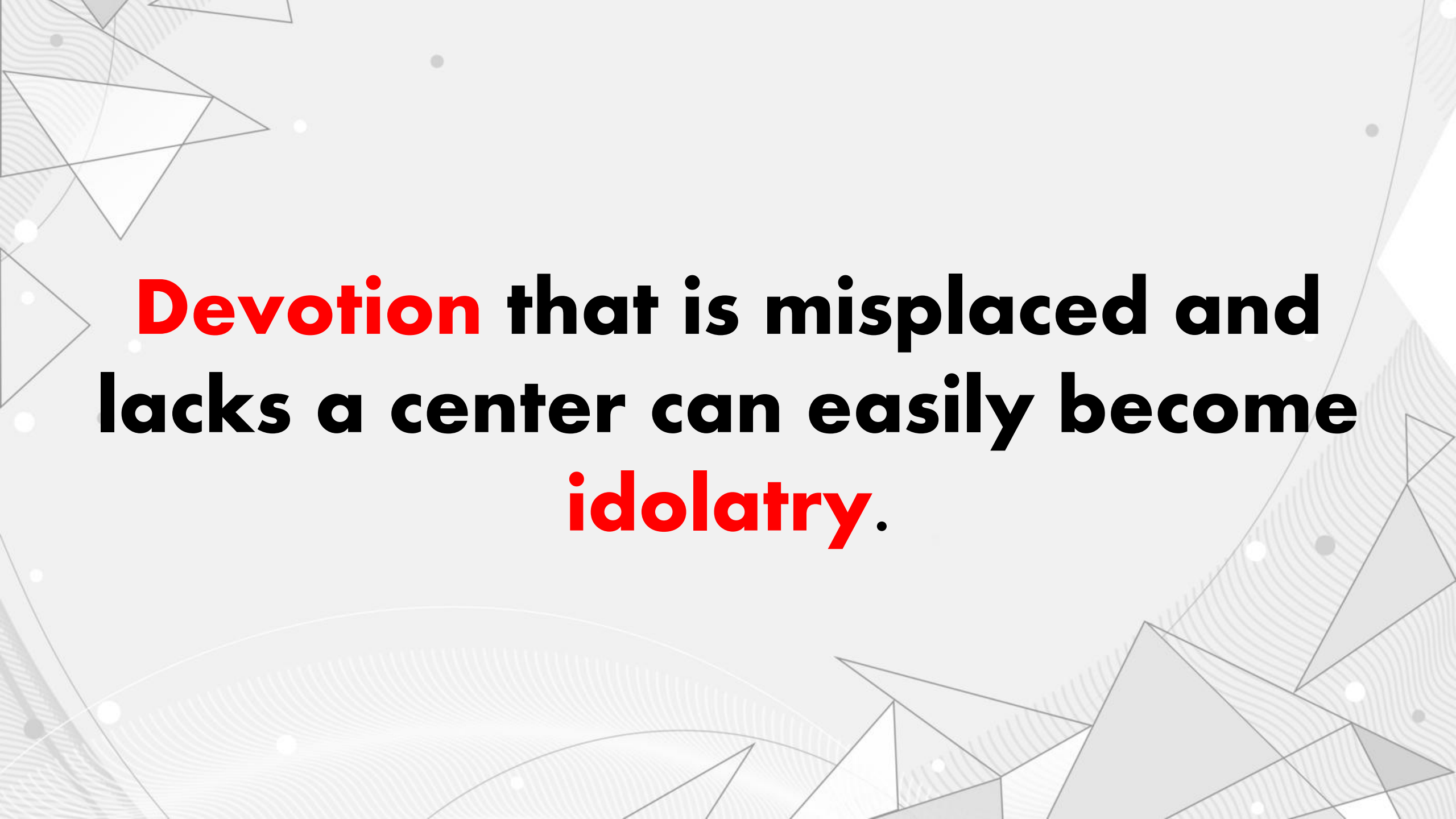

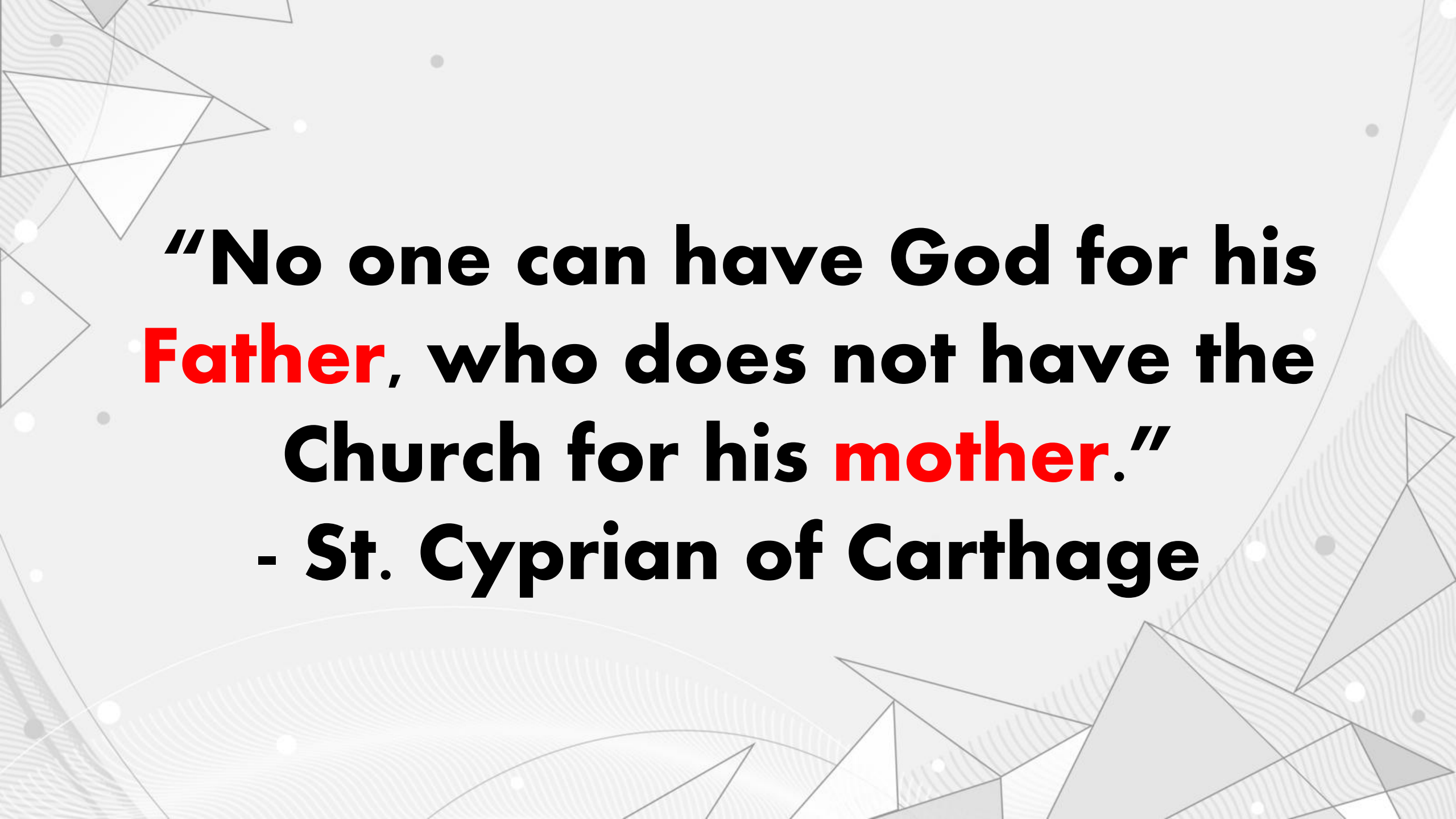




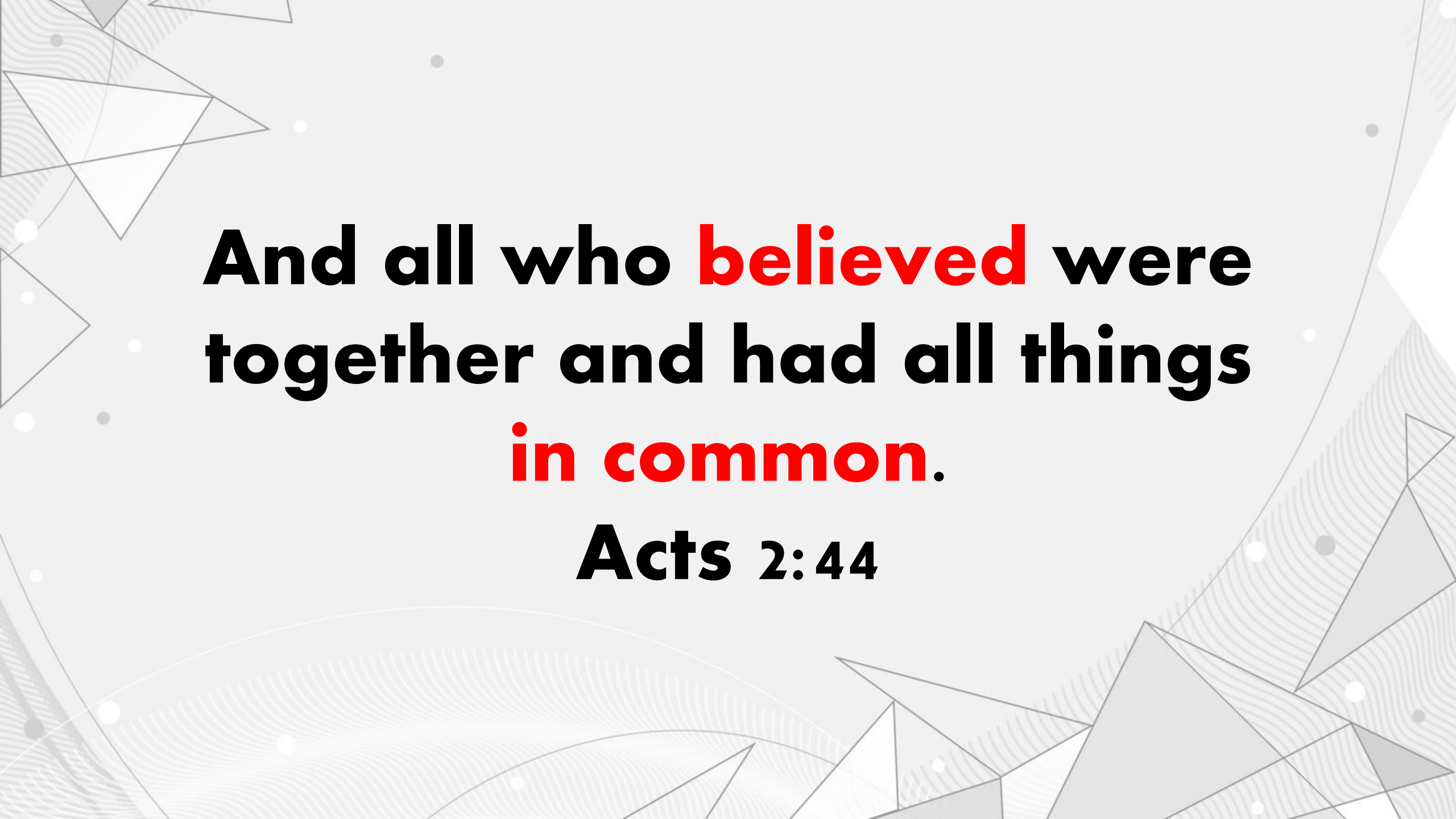
What you most **prioritize
