1 O Lord, our Lord, How majestic is Your name in all the earth, Who have displayed Your splendor above the heavens! 3 When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, The moon and the stars, which You have ordained;

Size of the Heavens Above

- Light travels at 186k miles per second,
- It takes 8 minutes for light to travel 93 million miles from the sun to earth,
- A light year is 5.9 trillion miles,
- Our solar system is 1 light year in diameter
- Nearest star to the sun is about 4.2 light years away
- Our sun is only one of more than 200 billion stars in our galaxy (Milky Way),
- Our Milky Way is one of more than 100 billion galaxies
