



# **The Messiah We Didn't Expect**



**Mar 12:28-44 ESV]** 28 And one of the scribes came up and heard them disputing with one another, and seeing that he answered them well, asked him, "Which commandment is the most important of all?" 29 Jesus answered, "The most important is, 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. 30 And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' 31 The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these." 32 And the scribe said to him, "You are right, Teacher. You have truly said that he is one, and there is no other besides him. 33 And to love him with all the heart and with all the understanding and with all the strength, and to love one's neighbor as oneself, is much more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices." 34 And when Jesus saw that he answered wisely, he said to him, "You are not far from the kingdom of God." And after that no one dared to ask him any more questions.

35 And as Jesus taught in the temple, he said, "How can the scribes say that the Christ is the son of David? 36 David himself, in the Holy Spirit, declared, "'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, until I put your enemies under your feet.'" 37 David himself calls him Lord. So how is he his son?" And the great throng heard him gladly. 38 And in his teaching he said, "Beware of the scribes, who like to walk around in long robes and like greetings in the marketplaces 39 and have the best seats in the synagogues and the places of honor at feasts, 40 who devour widows' houses and for a pretense make long prayers. They will receive the greater condemnation." 41 And he sat down opposite the treasury and watched the people putting money into the offering box. Many rich people put in large sums. 42 And a poor widow came and put in two small copper coins, which make a penny. 43 And he called his disciples to him and said to them, "Truly, I say to you, this poor widow has

**put in more than all those who are contributing to the offering box. 44 For they all contributed out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty has put in everything she had, all she had to live on.“**

**Jesus' Greatest Commandment, and the 2nd!**

**Mark 12:28-34**

**The Rabbi's have numbered 613 commandments in the Old Testament, 1**

**Rabbi: Maimonides, who enumerated them as 248 positive ("do this") and 365 negative ("do not do this") commands, and stated in the Talmud. Moses gave 10 Commandments, so a Scribe asks Jesus which is the foremost (greatest) Commandment of all? Can you state it without looking it up?**

**Where in the Old Testament did Jesus quote from?**

**What was Jesus' preface truth before the command?**

**What did Jesus state as the second foremost commandment?**

**Why did Jesus say this scribe was not far (But not in) the Kingdom of God?**

**What are the 3 “E”s that summarize our Philosophy of ministry at FBC? And in order.**

**How would you explain and describe the 3 “E”s and Jesus' greatest commandments?**

# THE GREATEST COMMANDMENT

MARK 12:28-34



This morning, we are preaching out of order, Today is the State of the Church Sonday!

We want to review our Philosophy of ministry – 3 “E”s!

Mar 12:28, 38-40 **And one of the scribes came up and heard them disputing with one another, and seeing that he answered them well, asked him, "Which commandment is the most important of all?" ...**

38 And in his teaching he said, "**Beware of the scribes, who like to walk around in long robes and like greetings in the marketplaces** 39 and have the best seats in the synagogues and the places of honor at feasts, 40 who devour widows' houses and for a pretense make long prayers. They will receive the greater condemnation."

**"The first of all the commandments is...KJV**

**"The most important commandment is...NLT**

**"The foremost is...NASB20...foremost of all...**

**"The first and most important one is...AMP**

**"The greatest is...HNV**

# RULEigion? – which is foremost?

- The Rabbi's number 613 commands in the OT, 248/365
- Moses lists 10, but we debate them (Exodus 34:28, Deuteronomy 4:13)
- Exodus 20:1-11 – a jealous God ... those who hate me/love me ...



**A very good question: RULEigion or Relationship! God is not seeking mindless Automatons or mere dutiful slaves!!**

**We are trying to keep the rules God, which are most important? Legalists missing the motive – Love!**

**[Exo 20:2-3 ESV] 2 "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. 3 "You shall have no other gods before me.**

[Jhn 8:32, 34, 36 and you will know the truth, and **the truth will set you free.**" ... 34 Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly I say to you, **everyone who commits sin is a slave of sin.** ... 36 "**So if the Son sets you free, you really will be free.**

[Jhn 15:15 "**No longer do I call you slaves**, for the slave does not know what his master is doing; **but I have called you friends**, because all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you.

## He is Jealous- Ex 20:1-11

[Exo 20:5-6 ESV] 5 You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, 6 but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments.

[Exo 34:28 ESV] 28 So he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights. He neither ate bread nor drank water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments.

[Exo 31:18 ESV] 18 And he gave to Moses, when he had finished speaking with him on Mount Sinai, the two tablets of the testimony, tablets of stone, written with the finger of God.

[Exo 32:16 ESV] 16 The tablets were the work of God, and the writing was the writing of God, engraved on the tablets.

[Deu 4:13 ESV] 13 And he declared to you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, that is, the Ten Commandments, and he wrote them on two tablets of stone.

[2Co 3:7 ESV] 7 Now if the ministry of death, carved in letters on stone, came with such

glory that the Israelites could not gaze at Moses' face because of its glory, which was being brought to an end,

**613 commands in the OT, 248/365 248 positive commands, 365 negative, thou shall NOT**

**[Mat 22:40 ESV] 40 On these two commandments depend (hang) all the Law and the Prophets."**


**[Rom 13:8-10 ESV] 8 Owe no one anything, except to love each other, for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law. 9 For the commandments, "You shall not commit adultery, You shall not murder, You shall not steal, You shall not covet," and any other commandment, are summed up in this word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." 10 Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.**

**[Jas 4:8 ESV] 8 Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.**

**[Heb 10:22 ESV] 22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.**

# ‘The Lord our God, the Lord is one’

- Deuteronomy 6:4 – “Hear, O Israel: the LORD our God, the LORD is one.” – the Shema, Monotheism  
(Deuteronomy 10:12, 30:6)
- Moses asked God, “What is His Name?” – Exodus 3:13
- We must Know God to Love Him! 1 yet 3 persons!  
(12:35-)

**Jesus reminds us of the Context before the Commands!!! Who God is!**

**God rescued/saved Israel, the people He made for himself, from evil taskmasters to come and worship/serve/obey him and they made a golden Calf!**

**[Exo 3:13 NASB20] 13 Then Moses said to God, "Behold, I am going to the sons of Israel, and I will say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you.' Now they may say to me, 'What is His name?' What shall I say to them?"**

**[Exo 3:14 NASB20] 14 And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM"; and He said, "This is what you shall say to the sons of Israel: 'I AM has sent me to you.'"**

**Stiff-necked Ingrates!**

**Exo 33:3, 5 ESV] 3 Go up to a land flowing with milk and honey; but I will not go up among you, lest I consume you on the way, for you are a stiff-necked people." ... 5 For the LORD had said to Moses, "Say to the people of Israel, 'You are a stiff-necked people; if for a single moment I should go up among you, I would consume you. So now take off your ornaments, that I may know what to do with you.'"**

**We must Know God to Love Him! 1 yet 3 persons!**

**He is worthy of our Love!**

[Exo 20:5-6 ESV] 5 You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for **I the LORD your God am a jealous God**, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation **of those who hate me**, 6 **but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments.**

**Deu 10:12 "And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul,**

**[Luk 10:42 ESV] 42 but one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen the good portion, which will not be taken away from her."** (Martha and Mary)

**Jhn 21:15 When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love you." He said to him, "Feed my lambs."**

### **He is Jealous- Ex 20:1-11**

[Exo 20:5-6 ESV] 5 You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for **I the LORD your God am a jealous God**, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and

fourth generation **of those who hate me, 6 but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments.**

[Luk 14:25-27, 33 ESV] 25 Now great crowds accompanied him, and he turned and said to them, 26 "If anyone comes to me and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. 27 Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple. ... 33 So therefore, any one of you who does not renounce all that he has cannot be my disciple.

*Shema* ("hear") is the Hebrew word that begins the most important prayer in Judaism. It is found in [Deuteronomy 6:4](#), which begins with the command to "Hear." The whole *Shema* prayer, which includes verses 4-9, is spoken daily in the Jewish tradition:

*Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.*

Later Jewish tradition developed a three-part *Shema* prayer that also included [Deuteronomy 11:13-29](#) and [Numbers 15:37-41](#). Tradition states these three parts cover all aspects of the Ten Commandments.


[Rom 13:10 ESV] 10 Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.

# God gave the Law to reveal us & Him!

- Romans 8:7 – For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot.
- John 3:19 – And this is the judgement: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light.
- Galatians 2:21 – I do not nullify the grace of God ...

# The 2<sup>nd</sup>! Horizontal, loving people

- Like the 1<sup>st</sup> commandment, Born to love!
  - Matthew 22:39
- Love God/Love His People! – 1 John 4:12, 20
- Scripture is clear, there are 2 types of people!



**[Mat 22:39 ESV]** 39 And **a second is like it**: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.

## The 1st Commandment is Vertical! Points up!

**[Luk 10:27-29 ESV]** 27 And he answered, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind, **and your neighbor as yourself.**" 28 And he said to him, "You have answered correctly; do this, and you will live." 29 But he, desiring to justify himself, said to Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?"

**[1Jo 4:12 ESV]** 12 **No one has ever seen God; if we love one another, God abides in us and his love is perfected in us.**

**[1Jo 4:20 ESV]** 20 **If anyone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen.**

**[1Jo 3:17 ESV]** 17 **But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's love abide in him?**

**[Jas 2:18 ESV]** 18 But someone will say, "You have faith and I have works." Show me your faith apart from your works, and I will show you my faith by my works.

**[Jhn 13:35 ESV] 35 By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.“**

**[Jhn 17:21 ESV] 21 that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.**



# Love the Lost!

- Evangelism is sharing the ‘good news’ with the hopeless enemies of God, that He loves them and died for them so they can be born again and made His and able to love Him who 1<sup>st</sup> loved us!
- Romans 9:3 – For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, my kinsmen according to the flesh.

**Love the Lost by giving them the gospel which can save their souls for eternity instead of simply making their ride on the Titanic more comfortable**

[Rom 9:2-4, 6-8, 31 that I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart. 3 For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, my kinsmen according to the flesh. 4 They are Israelites, and to them belong the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the worship, and the promises. ... 6 But it is not as though the word of God has failed. For not all who are descended from Israel belong to Israel, 7 and not all are children of Abraham because they are his offspring, but "Through Isaac shall your offspring be named." 8 This means that it is not the children of the flesh who are the children of God, but the children of the promise are counted as offspring. ... 31 but that Israel who pursued a law that would lead to righteousness did not succeed in reaching that law.

[Exo 32:32 ESV] 32 But now, if you will forgive their sin--but if not, please blot me out of your book that you have written.“

[1Th 2:8 ESV] 8 So, being affectionately desirous of you, we were ready to share with you not only the gospel of God but also our own selves, because you had become very dear to us.







Worship always brings us to our knees

[Luk 7:44-50 ESV] 44 Then turning toward the woman he said to Simon, "Do you see this woman? I entered your house; you gave me no water for my feet, but she has wet my feet with her tears and wiped them with her hair. 45 You gave me no kiss, but from the time I came in she has not ceased to kiss my feet. 46 You did not anoint my head with oil, but she has anointed my feet with ointment. 47 Therefore I tell you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven--for she loved much. But he who is forgiven little, loves little." 48 And he said to her, "Your sins are forgiven." 49 Then those who were at table with him began to say among themselves, "Who is this, who even forgives sins?" 50 And he said to the woman, "Your faith has saved you; go in peace."


[Gal 2:20 ESV] 20 I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

[2Co 5:14 ESV] 14 For the love of Christ controls us, because we have concluded this: that one has died for all, therefore all have died;

[2Th 3:5 ESV] 5 May the Lord direct your hearts to the love of God and to the steadfastness of Christ.

[1Jo 3:23 ESV] 23 And this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as he has commanded us.

## Did you know there are different Versions of the 10 Commandments

### Catholic & Luthern:

1. I am the LORD your God: you shall not have strange Gods before me.
2. You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain.
3. Remember to keep holy the LORD'S Day.
4. Honor your father and your mother.
5. You shall not kill.
6. You shall not commit adultery.
7. You shall not steal.
8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.
10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

### Protestant: (excluding Lutherns)

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




