







- Those who tend gardens MUST Kill the Weeds!

Kathy Kehoe, 73, of Falls Township in Bucks County spotted the reptile on her property on Monday after she heard birds squawking outside.

"I opened the door. I said a bad word [and then] 'it's a cobra.' I knew right away," Kehoe told ABC 6.

Kehoe snapped a few photos of the nearly 5-foot-long snake, which made it to her doorstep, before she slew the beast with a shovel.





How to crucify the flesh

Recognize the truth; we can't trust our flesh, sin never satisfies and never get away with it. Recognize Lies! They are often subtle.

Passionately pursuing Christ. Not enough just to be" Saved"! Can't have one foot in Egypt. Intentional Christianity. He is worth the fight!

Repent, daily. For sin is daily. Take sin seriously. It breaks Gods heart. • When is the last time you confessed sin? Or repented?

Sin is personal. Not about breaking rules, it's about offending He who loves me most. It's a love issue Surrender our will believing His is better! Joseph

Die daily. Crucify my will! Pick up the cross. Myopia and see past this word. Memento mori vs carpe diem

Weeds in the garden! Sow righteousness! Elephant training.

Identify/detect the devils lies!

[2Co 10:3-6 NASB20] 3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not wage battle according to the flesh, 4 for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. 5 [We are] destroying arguments and all arrogance raised against the knowledge of God, and [we are] taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ, 6 and we are ready to punish all disobedience, whenever your obedience is complete.

# How do we Crucify our flesh?

- Passionately pursue Christ. Follow Him!
  - Study scripture, it's the primary means of His leading!
  - Pray! Pray and Pray some more
  - The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit (6<sup>th</sup> sense)
  - Koinonia, fellowship, the church

- Remember my proclivity to sin. Jeremiah 17:9, flesh is weak!
- Remember Lot's wife! Burn those bridges. Hand-Plough
- Repent, die daily. For sin is daily. Take sin seriously.
- Perspective Sin is personal! It's a love issue!
- Believe/trust God! Isaiah 55:8-9; Genesis 45, 50:20

[1Co 15:31 NASB20] 31 I affirm, brothers [and sisters,] by the boasting in you which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, that I die daily.



The Holy Spirit often gives us offramps from our sin and we usually refuse to take them!!

[Mat 7:14 NLT] 14 But the gateway to life is very narrow and the road is difficult, and only a few ever find it.

[2Sa 11:3 NASB20] 3 So David sent [servants] and inquired about the woman. And [someone] said, "Is this not Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam, the wife of Uriah the Hittite?"

[Rom 8:1 NASB20] 1 Therefore there is now no condemnation at all for those who are in Christ Jesus.

[Heb 12:4-16 NASB20] 4 You have not yet resisted to the point of shedding blood in your striving against sin; 5 and you have forgotten the exhortation which is addressed to you as sons, "MY SON, DO NOT REGARD LIGHTLY THE DISCIPLINE OF THE LORD, NOR FAINT WHEN YOU ARE PUNISHED BY HIM; 6 FOR WHOM THE LORD LOVES HE DISCIPLINES, AND HE PUNISHES EVERY SON WHOM HE ACCEPTS." 7 It is for discipline that you endure; God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom [his] father does not discipline? 8 But if you are without discipline, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate children and not sons. 9 Furthermore, we had earthly fathers to discipline us, and we respected [them;] shall we not much more be subject to the Father of spirits, and live? 10 For they disciplined [us] for a short time as seemed best to them, but He [disciplines us] for [our] good, so that we may share His holiness. 11 For the moment, all discipline seems not to be pleasant, but painful; yet to those who have been trained by it, afterward it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness. 12 Therefore, strengthen the hands that are weak and the knees that are feeble, 13 and make straight paths for your feet, so that [the limb] which is impaired may not be dislocated, but rather be healed. 14 Pursue peace with all people, and the holiness without which no one will see the Lord. 15 See to it that no one comes short of the grace of God; that no root of bitterness springing up causes trouble, and by it many become defiled; 16 that [there be] no sexually immoral or godless

person like Esau, who sold his own birthright for a [single] meal.

#### Humble ourselves or be humiliated!

- Let's not become boastful, challenging one another, envying one another – Galatians 5:26
- Humility is the miracle grow of the fruit of the Spirit!
- Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility consider one another as more important than yourselves – Philippians 2:3



yourselves; 4 do not [merely] look out for your own personal [interests,] but also for the [interests] of others. 5 Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, as He [already] existed in the form of God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, 7 but emptied Himself [by] taking the form of a bond-servant [and] being born in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death: death on a cross. 9 For this reason also God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, 10 so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and [that] every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. 12 So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; 13 for it is God who is at work in you, both to desire and to work for [His] good pleasure. 14 Do all things without complaining or arguments;





[Rom 8:13 NASB20] 13 for if you are living in accord with the flesh, you are going to die; but if by the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body, you will live.

[Gal 5:24 NASB20] 24 Now those who belong to Christ Jesus crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

[Rom 6:6 NASB20] 6 knowing this, that our old self was crucified with [Him,] in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin;

[Act 20:23 NASB20] 23 except that the Holy Spirit solemnly testifies to me in every city, saying that

chains and afflictions await me.

[2Co 4:10-11 NASB20] 10 always carrying around in the body the dying of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body. 11 For we who live are constantly being handed over to death because of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our mortal flesh.
