The story of Noah is **<u>the 1<sup>st</sup> time the word covenant comes up</u>**. But not the 1<sup>st</sup> Covenant

How many covenants were there? Answers range from 4-10 but ultimately 1 overarching will of God. Eph.1

[Gen 6:18, 22 NASB20] 18 "**But I will establish My covenant with you; and you shall enter the ark--you, your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives with you**. ... 22 So Noah did [these things;] according to everything that God had commanded him, so he did.

[Gen 9:8-9 NASB20] 8 Then God spoke to Noah and to his sons with him, saying, 9 "Now behold, I Myself am establishing My covenant with you, and with your descendants after you;

## A Covenantal God! – Genesis 6:18

• Genesis 9:8-9 – Then God spoke to Noah and to his sons with him, saying, "Now behold, <u>I Myself</u> <u>am establishing My covenant with you</u>, and with your descendants after you;

•A Covenant is; a Promise, pledge, more than a contract

Gen 6:18 "<u>But I will establish My covenant with you; and you shall enter the ark</u>-you, your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives with you.

A Covenant is a treaty, a compact,

Marriage is a "Binding" Covenant, much more than a contract

Many times covenants are made with Blood! A blood oath

[Exo 24:1-8 NASB20] 1 Then He said to Moses, "Come up to the LORD, you and Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, and you shall worship at a distance. 2 "Moses alone, however, shall approach the LORD, but they shall not approach, nor shall the people come up with him." 3 Then Moses came and reported to the people all the words of the LORD and all the ordinances; and all the people answered with one voice and said, "All the words which the LORD has spoken we will do!" 4 And Moses wrote down all the words of the LORD. Then he got up early in the morning, and built an altar at the foot of the mountain with twelve memorial stones for the twelve tribes of Israel. 5 And he sent young men of

the sons of Israel, and they offered burnt offerings and sacrificed bulls as peace offerings to the LORD. 6 Moses took half of the blood and put [it] in basins, and the [other] half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar. 7 Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read [it] as the people listened; and they said, "All that the LORD has spoken we will do, and we will be obedient!" 8 So Moses took the blood and sprinkled [it] on the people, and said, "Behold the blood of the covenant, which the LORD has made with you in accordance with all these words."

John Owen gives some helpful theological insight into the ritual here described by the author of Hebrews. "This distribution of blood, half on the altar, half on the people, one to make atonement, the other to purify or sanctify, taught the double efficacy of Christ's blood in making atonement for sin for our justification and purifying of our natures in sanctification." The ineffectual animal blood that Moses used ratified the old covenant and pointed to the need for effectual blood to ratify the new one. Just as blood had to be shed to dedicate the old covenant, Christ had to die to consecrate the new one. And without His death we do not have peace with God.



Only a few of these points are in scripture, the rest are assumed by the Rabbis. Law and Order – Capital punishment

According to Judaism, <u>a Gentile does not have to follow the Mosaic Law;</u> <u>however, all Gentiles are obliged to follow the Noahide Laws. The laws given to</u> <u>Noah's children are universally binding. A non-Jew who abides by the Noahide</u> <u>Laws is considered a "righteous Gentile,</u>" according to Judaism, and will earn a reward in the afterlife, if his obedience is coupled with a knowledge that the laws come from God. A "righteous Gentile" might also be called a "Hasidic Gentile" or simply a "Noahide." https://www.gotquestions.org/Noahide-laws.html

My Rabbi friend told me were fortunate! Us Gentiles only have the 7 Noah laws to keep, He has 613!!

But we cant even keep the 7! At least its NOT 10 or 613!



Most, if not all, Covenants require Blood!!

Again! The Ark is Amazing but it was the Altar that should capture our attention!! Don't miss the Altar!

[Heb 9:18-20 NASB20] 18 **Therefore even the first [covenant] was not inaugurated without blood**. 19 For when every commandment had been spoken by Moses to all the people according to the Law, he took the blood of the calves and the goats, with water and scarlet wool and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book itself and all the people, 20 saying, "**THIS IS THE BLOOD OF THE COVENANT WHICH GOD COMMANDED YOU.**"

Hebrew brethren, this is what we were waiting for! [Heb 9:22 NASB20] 22 And almost all things are cleansed with blood, according to the Law, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.

Jesus, Lords supper. 1Co 11:25 In the same way [He] also [took] the cup after

supper, saying, "<u>This cup is the new covenant in My blood</u>; do this, as often as you drink [it,] in remembrance of Me."



We're not going to go too deep into the debate between Covenantal and Dispensational Theologies today but we can't ignore them either

Malachi 3:6 "For I the LORD do not change; therefore you, O children of Jacob, are not consumed.

Numbers 23:19 ESV God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

<u>Hebrews 6:18</u> ESV So that by two unchangeable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have fled for refuge might have strong encouragement to hold fast to the hope set before us.

Westminster Seminary = Covenant Theology!

Cairn (PBU) University WAS Dispensational. Ryrie

This especially matters in relation to the people of Israel

Its almost as much of a tension as Free will vs. Doctrines of Grace/Reformed Theology (election and Predestination)

This is Why we don't talk about God as IF He is different from the Old Testament and the New! He doesn't change! He's the same yesterday, today and forever!



Clearly God is dealing with people <u>DRAMATICALLY</u> differently after the Flood!

Life has changed but God Has NOT!

Covenant theologians wouldn't argue this change. <u>Why are some things wrong</u> <u>some times but not all times?</u>

Like me and my 7 year old son and 17 year old son!

Eating meat was essential in OT, Part of Sacrifices and Passover!

Some things don't change

People are just as depraved!!

God is just as longsuffering and loving and full of grace!

#### Still worshipping through Altars and the Blood!


Psa 104:5-8 He established the earth upon its foundations, So that it will not totter forever and ever. 6 You covered it with the deep sea as with a garment; The waters were standing above the mountains. 7 They fled from Your rebuke, At the sound of Your thunder they hurried away. <u>8 The mountains rose; the valleys sank down To the place which You established for them</u>.

Racism? Only 1 Race!

Variation within Species!

[Gen 9:3 NASB20] 3 "Every moving thing that is alive shall be food for you; I have given everything to you, as [I gave] the green plant.

[Gen 1:29-30 NASB20] 29 Then God said, "Behold, I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the surface of all the earth, and every tree which has fruit yielding seed; it shall be food for you; 30 and to every animal of the earth and to every bird of the sky and to everything that moves on the earth which has life, [I have given] every green plant for food"; and it was so.



- 1. God Swore!

#### **Right after Isa.53**

Isa 54:9-10 NASB20 "For this is like the days of Noah to Me, When I swore that the waters of Noah Would not flood the earth again; So I have sworn that I will not be angry with you Nor rebuke you. 10 "For the mountains may be removed and the hills may shake, But My favor will not be removed from you, Nor will My covenant of peace be shaken," Says the LORD who has compassion on you.

Context always helps, see below

[Isa 54:5-8 NASB20] 5 "For your husband is your Maker, Whose name is the LORD of armies; And your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel, Who is called the God of all the earth. 6 "For the LORD has called you, Like a wife forsaken and grieved in spirit, Even like a wife of [one's] youth when she is rejected," Says your God. 7 "**For** 

**a brief moment I abandoned you**, But with great compassion I will gather you. 8 "In an outburst of anger I hid My face from you for a moment, **But with everlasting favor I will have compassion on you**," Says the LORD your Redeemer.

The chapter before was about Jesus our Savior! The price of the covenant of peace!

Isa 53:1-12 Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed? 2 For He grew up before Him like a tender shoot, And like a root out of dry ground; He has no [stately] form or majesty That we would look at Him, Nor an appearance that we would take pleasure in Him. 3 He was despised and abandoned by men, A man of great pain and familiar with sickness; And like one from whom [people] hide their faces, He was despised, and we had no regard for Him. 4 However, [it was] our sicknesses [that] He Himself bore, And our pains [that] He carried; Yet we ourselves assumed that He had been afflicted, Struck down by God, and humiliated. 5 But He was pierced for our offenses, He was crushed for our wrongdoings; The punishment for our well-being [was laid] upon Him, And by His wounds we are healed. 6 All of us, like sheep, have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the LORD has caused the wrongdoing of us all To fall on Him. 7 He was oppressed and afflicted, Yet He did not open His mouth; Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, So He did not open His mouth. 8 By oppression and judgment He was taken away; And as for His generation, who considered That He was cut off from the land of the living For the wrongdoing of my people, to whom the blow [was due?] 9 And His grave was assigned with wicked men, Yet He was with a rich man in His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor was there any deceit in His mouth. 10 But the LORD desired To crush Him, causing [Him] grief; If He renders Himself [as] a guilt offering, He will see [His] offspring, He will prolong [His] days, And the good pleasure of the LORD will prosper in His hand. 11 As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see [it and] be satisfied; By His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, For He will bear their wrongdoings. 12 Therefore, I will allot Him a portion with the great, And He will divide the plunder with the strong, Because He poured out His life unto death, And was counted with wrongdoers; Yet He Himself bore the sin of many, And interceded for the wrongdoers.

• 2 Peter 3:3-4 – Know this first [of all,] that in the last days mockers will come with [their] mocking, following after their own lusts, and saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? ... the world at that time was destroyed by being flooded with water.

[2Pe 3:3-9 NASB20] 3 Know this first [of all,] that in the last days mockers will come with [their] mocking, following after their own lusts, 4 and saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? For [ever] since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue just as [they were] from the beginning of creation." 5 For when they maintain this, it escapes their notice that by the word of God [the] heavens existed long ago and [the] earth was formed out of water and by water, 6 through which **the world at that time was destroyed by being flooded with water. 7 But by His word the present heavens and earth are being reserved for fire**, kept for the day of judgment and destruction of ungodly people. 8 But do not let this one [fact] escape your notice, beloved, that with the Lord one day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years like one day. 9 <u>The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not willing for any to perish, but for all to come to repentance.</u>

# IF you pay special attention its absolutely extraordinary how Noah addresses our day!

### [Gen 1:27 NASB20] 27 So <u>God created man in His own image, in the image of God</u> <u>He created him; male and female He created them</u>. Mt.18!

[Gen 5:2 NASB20] 2 He created them male and female, and He blessed them and named them "mankind" on the day when they were created.

[Gen 6:19 NASB20] 19 "And of every living thing of all flesh, you shall bring two of every [kind] into the ark, to keep [them] alive with you; they shall be male and female.

[Gen 7:2-3, 9, 16 NASB20] 2 "You shall take with you seven pairs of every clean animal, a male and his female; and two of the animals that are not clean, a male and his female; 3 also of the birds of the sky, seven pairs, male and female, to keep [their] offspring alive on the face of all the earth. ... 9 they [all] went into the ark to Noah by twos, male and female, as God had commanded Noah. ... 16 Those that entered, male and female of all flesh, entered as God had commanded him; and the LORD closed [the door] behind him. [Gen 1:11-12, 21, 24-25 NASB20] 11 Then God said, "Let the earth sprout vegetation, plants yielding seed, [and] fruit trees on the earth bearing fruit according to their kind with seed in them"; and it was so. 12 The earth produced vegetation, plants yielding seed according to their kind, and trees bearing fruit with seed in them, according to their kind; and God saw that it was good. ... 21 And God created the great sea creatures and every living creature that moves, with which the waters swarmed, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind; and God saw that it was good. ... 24 Then God said, "Let the earth produce living creatures according to their kind ilvestock and crawling things and animals of the earth according to their kind, and the livestock according to their kind, and everything that crawls on the ground according to its kind; and God saw that it was good.

[Gen 6:20 NASB20] 20 "Of the birds according to their kind, and of the animals according to their kind, of every crawling thing of the ground according to its kind, two of every [kind] will come to you to keep [them] alive.

[Gen 7:14 NASB20] 14 they and every animal according to its kind, and all the livestock according to their kind, and every crawling thing that crawls on the earth according to its kind, and every bird according to its kind, all sorts of birds.

### Both revel in and forbid marriage!

[Luk 17:27 NASB20] 27 [people] were eating, they were drinking, <u>they were</u> <u>marrying</u>, [and] they were being given in marriage, until the day that Noah <u>entered the ark</u>, and the flood came and destroyed them all.

[<u>**1Ti 4:3**</u>NASB20] 3 <u>who forbid marriage</u> [and advocate] abstaining from foods which God has created to be gratefully shared in by those who believe and know the truth.

[Mat 19:3-6 NASB20] 3 [Some] Pharisees came to Jesus, testing Him and asking, "Is it lawful [for a man] to divorce his wife for any reason [at all?]" 4 And He answered and said, "Have you not read that He who created [them] from the beginning MADE THEM MALE AND FEMALE, 5 and said, 'FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND HIS MOTHER AND BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH'? 6 "So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore, what God has joined together, no person is to separate."

Rom 1:28-31 And just as they did not see fit to acknowledge God, God gave them up to a depraved mind, to do those things that are not proper, 29 [people] having been filled with all unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, [and] evil; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, [and] malice; [they are] gossips, 30 slanderers, <u>haters of God</u>, insolent, arrogant, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents, 31 without understanding, untrustworthy, <u>unfeeling</u>, [and] unmerciful;

[2Ti 3:3 NASB20] 3 **unloving[G794**], irreconcilable, malicious gossips, without self-control, brutal, haters of good, (without natural affection)

[Jer 19:5 NET] 5 They have built places here for worship of the god Baal so that they could sacrifice their children as burnt offerings to him in the fire. Such sacrifices are something I never commanded them to make! They are something I never told them to do! Indeed, such a thing never even entered my mind!

[Jer 32:35 NET] 35 They built places of worship for the god Baal in the Valley of Ben Hinnom so that they could sacrifice their sons and daughters to the god Molech. Such a disgusting practice was not something I commanded them to do! It never even entered my mind to command them to do such a thing! So Judah is certainly liable for punishment.'

1Ti 4:3 who forbid marriage [and advocate] **<u>abstaining from foods which God has</u>** <u>**created to be gratefully shared in**</u> by those who believe and know the truth.

[Col 2:20-23 NASB20] 20 If you have died with Christ to the elementary principles of the world, why, as if you were living in the world, do you submit yourself to decrees, [such as,] 21 "Do not handle, <u>do not taste</u>, do not touch!" 22 (which all [refer] [to] things destined to perish with use)--in accordance with the commandments and teachings of man? 23 These are matters which do have the appearance of wisdom in self-made religion and humility and severe treatment of

### the body, [but are] of no value against fleshly indulgence.

[Heb 13:9 NASB20] 9 Do not be **misled by varied and strange teachings; for it is good for the heart to be strengthened by grace, not by foods**, through which those who were so occupied were not benefited.

[1Ti 4:4 NASB20] 4 For everything created by God is good, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with gratitude;

[2Ti 4:3-4 NASB20] 3 For [the] time will come when they will not tolerate sound doctrine; but [wanting] to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance with their own desires, 4 and they will turn their ears away from the truth and will turn aside to myths.

[2Th 2:8-10 NASB20] 8 Then that lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will eliminate with the breath of His mouth and bring to an end by the appearance of His coming; 9 [that is,] the one whose coming is in accord with the activity of Satan, with all power and false signs and wonders, 10 and with all the deception of wickedness for those who perish, because they did not accept the love of the truth so as to be saved.

[Dan 7:25 'And he will speak against the Most High and wear down the saints of

the Highest One, and he will intend to make alterations in times and in law; and they will be handed over to him for a time, times, and half a time.

[1Jo 2:18 NASB20] 18 Children, it is the last hour; and just as you heard that antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have appeared; from this we know that it is the last hour.



# 1 and 10, From perfect sinless state to the same but better, Glorified

- Adam failed, Jesus is the 2<sup>nd</sup> Adam! Rom.5:14, 1Cor.15:22, 45 [1Co 15:22, 45 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be made alive. ... 45 So also it is written: "The first MAN, Adam, BECAME A LIVING PERSON." The last Adam [was] a life-giving spirit. (God clothed Adam and Eve, Abel practiced what he'd learned)
- Noah failed But Jesus is our Baptism/Ark! 1Pet.3:18-21, 2Pet.2:4-9 [1Pe 3:21 NASB20] 21 Corresponding to that, baptism now saves you--not the removal of dirt from the flesh, but an appeal to God for a good conscience--<u>through the</u> <u>resurrection of Jesus Christ</u>, (Noah built and Altar and sacrificed all clean animals)
- Abraham failed But Jesus is the Lamb God provided! [Gen 22:2, 8, 14 NASB20] 2 Then He said, "Take now your son, your only son, whom you love, Isaac, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I will tell you." ... 8 Abraham said, "God will provide for Himself the lamb for the burnt offering, my son." So the two of them walked on together. ... 14 And Abraham named that place The LORD Will Provide, as it is said to this day, "On the mountain of the LORD it will be provided."[Jhn 8:52, 56, 58 NASB20] 52 The Jews said to Him, "Now we know that You have a demon. Abraham died, and the prophets [as well;] and [yet] You say, 'If anyone follows My word, he will never taste of death.' ... 56 "Your father Abraham was overjoyed that he would see My day, and he saw [it] and rejoiced." ... 58 Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am.", [Gal 3:6, 8-9 NLT] 6 In the same way, "Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith." ... 8 What's more, the Scriptures looked forward to this time when God would declare the Gentiles to be righteous because of their faith. God proclaimed this good news to Abraham long ago when he said, "All nations will be blessed through you." 9 So all who put their faith in Christ share the same blessing Abraham received because of his faith. (Sacrifice of Isaac, replaced with a Ram)
- Moses/Law failed. [Heb 3:3 NASB20] 3 For He has been counted worthy of more

**glory than Moses**, by just so much as the builder of the house has more honor than the house. [Gal 3:10, 13 NLT] 10 But those who depend on the law to make them right with God are under his curse, for the Scriptures say, "Cursed is everyone who does not observe and obey all the commands that are written in God's Book of the Law." ... 13 But Christ has rescued us from the curse pronounced by the law. When he was hung on the cross, he took upon himself the curse for our wrongdoing. For it is written in the Scriptures, "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree." (all the sacrifices, Passover) You have heard it said But I say to you! **Moses was a Levite, Jesus from tribe of Judah. Joseph is a better representative.** Jesus was from order of Melchizedek, Joshua followed Moses! Brought promised land!

David failed. Jesus is the better Son of David Isa.9 [Act 13:32-34 NLT] 32 "And now we are here to bring you this Good News. The promise was made to our ancestors, 33 and God has now fulfilled it for us, their descendants, by raising Jesus. This is what the second psalm says about Jesus: 'You are my Son. Today I have become your Father.' 34 For God had promised to raise him from the dead, not leaving him to rot in the grave. He said, 'I will give you the sacred blessings I promised to David.', [1Sa 16:5-8, 10-13 NLT] 5 "Yes," Samuel replied. "I have come to sacrifice to the LORD. Purify yourselves and come with me to the sacrifice." Then Samuel performed the purification rite for Jesse and his sons and invited them to the sacrifice, too. 6 When they arrived, Samuel took one look at Eliab and thought, "Surely this is the LORD's anointed!" 7 But the LORD said to Samuel, "Don't judge by his appearance or height, for I have rejected him. The LORD doesn't see things the way you see them. People judge by outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." 8 Then Jesse told his son Abinadab to step forward and walk in front of Samuel. But Samuel said, "This is not the one the LORD has chosen." ... 10 In the same way all seven of Jesse's sons were presented to Samuel. But Samuel said to Jesse, "The LORD has not chosen any of these." 11 Then Samuel asked, "Are these all the sons you have?" "There is still the youngest," Jesse replied. "But he's out in the fields watching the sheep and goats." "Send for him at once," Samuel said. "We will not sit down to eat until he arrives." 12 So Jesse sent for him. He was dark and handsome, with beautiful eyes. And the LORD said, "This is the one; anoint him." 13 So as David stood there among his brothers, Samuel took the flask of olive oil he had brought and anointed David with the oil. And the Spirit of the LORD came powerfully upon David from that day on. Then Samuel returned

to Ramah.

Old testament failed. Grace/New Covenant! [Jer 31:27-40 "Behold, days are coming," declares the LORD, "when I will sow the house of Israel and the house of Judah with the seed of mankind and the seed of animals. 28 "And just as I have watched over them to uproot [them,] tear [them] down, ruin, destroy, and bring disaster [on them,] so I will watch over them to build and to plant [them,]" declares the LORD. 29 "In those days they will no longer say, 'The fathers have eaten sour grapes, But [it is] the children's teeth [that] have become blunt.' 30 "But everyone will die for his own wrongdoing; each person who eats the sour grapes, his [own] teeth will become blunt. 31 "Behold, days are coming," declares the LORD, "when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, 32 not like the covenant which I made with their fathers on the day I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was a husband to them," declares the LORD. 33 "For this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days," declares the LORD: "I will put My law within them and write it on their heart; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. 34 "They will not teach again, each one his neighbor and each one his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them," declares the LORD, "for I will forgive their wrongdoing, and their sin I will no longer remember." 35 This is what the LORD says, [He] who gives the sun for light by day And the fixed order of the moon and the stars for light by night, Who stirs up the sea so that its waves roar-- The LORD of armies is His name: 36 "If this fixed order departs From Me," declares the LORD, "Then the descendants of Israel also will cease To be a nation before Me forever." 37 This is what the LORD says: "If the heavens above can be measured And the foundations of the earth searched out below, Then I will also reject all the descendants of Israel For everything that they have done," declares the LORD. 38 "Behold, days are coming," declares the LORD, "when the city will be rebuilt for the LORD from the Tower of Hananel to the Corner Gate. 39 "The measuring line will go out farther straight ahead, to the hill Gareb; then it will turn to Goah. 40 "And the entire valley of the dead bodies and of the ashes, and all the fields as far as the brook Kidron to the corner of the Horse Gate toward the east, shall be holy to the LORD; it will not be uprooted or overthrown ever again."[Heb 8:7-13 NASB20] 7 For if that first [covenant] had been free of fault, no circumstances would have been sought for a second. 8 For in finding fault with the

people, He says, "BEHOLD, DAYS ARE COMING, SAYS THE LORD, WHEN I WILL BRING ABOUT A NEW COVENANT WITH THE HOUSE OF ISRAEL AND THE HOUSE OF JUDAH, 9 NOT LIKE THE COVENANT WHICH I MADE WITH THEIR FATHERS ON THE DAY I TOOK THEM BY THE HAND TO BRING THEM OUT OF THE LAND OF EGYPT; FOR THEY DID NOT CONTINUE IN MY COVENANT, AND I DID NOT CARE ABOUT THEM, SAYS THE LORD. 10 "FOR THIS IS THE COVENANT WHICH I WILL MAKE WITH THE HOUSE OF ISRAEL AFTER THOSE DAYS, DECLARES THE LORD: I WILL PUT MY LAWS INTO THEIR MINDS, AND WRITE THEM ON THEIR HEARTS. AND I WILL BE THEIR GOD, AND THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE. 11 "AND THEY WILL NOT TEACH, EACH ONE HIS FELLOW CITIZEN, AND EACH ONE HIS BROTHER, SAYING, 'KNOW THE LORD,' FOR THEY WILL ALL KNOW ME, FROM THE LEAST TO THE GREATEST OF THEM. 12 "FOR I WILL BE MERCIFUL TOWARD THEIR WRONGDOINGS, AND THEIR SINS I WILL NO LONGER REMEMBER." 13 When He said, "A new [covenant,]" He has made the first obsolete. But whatever is becoming obsolete and growing old is about to disappear. [1Co 11:25] NASB20] 25 In the same way [He] also [took] the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink [it,] in remembrance of Me."






#### 1 Seed saves, many peoples are saved!

[Gal 3:8, 11, 15-22 NASB20] 8 The Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, [saying,] "ALL THE NATIONS WILL BE BLESSED IN YOU." ... 11 Now, that no one is justified by the Law before God is evident; for, "THE RIGHTEOUS ONE WILL LIVE BY FAITH." ... 15 Brothers [and sisters,] I speak in terms of human relations: even though it is [only] a man's covenant, yet when it has been ratified, no one sets it aside or adds conditions to it. 16 Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. He does not say, "And to seeds," as [one would in referring] to many, but [rather] as [in referring] to one, "And to your seed," that is, Christ. 17 What I am saying is this: the Law, which came 430 years later, does not invalidate a covenant previously ratified by God, so as to nullify the promise. 18 For if the inheritance is based on law, it is no longer based on a promise; but God has granted it to Abraham by means of a promise. 19 Why the Law then? It was added on account of the violations, having been ordered through angels at the hand of a mediator, until the Seed would come to whom the promise had been made. 20 Now a mediator is not for one [party only;] but God is [only] one. 21 Is the Law then contrary to the promises of God? Far from it! For if a law had been given that was able to impart life, then righteousness would indeed have been based on law. 22 But the Scripture has confined everyone under sin, so that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be

given to those who believe.
