

“Satan also came... From roaming about”! Alt. title: “**Does Job fear God for nothing?**” Job 1:6-2:10, 1Pet.5:8, 2Tim.4:17, Eccl.2. 3 categories people, possessions, pleasures (absence of displeasures). Our enemies in a hostile world and/or Why does Job fear God? For Who God is or for what God gives me? Treatise against health/wealth/prosperity. Does God want His people to suffer? Is some suffering punishment for sin? Jn.9:2, 1 Cor.11. This one could be 2 messages.

“Does Job fear God for nothing?”

Satan is asking the question but what does he mean?

Is he asking if jobs faith is misplaced and inevitably meaningless?

He is in essence saying Job serves God for the blessings! Here, he attacks Jobs motives and says Job only serves God for the benefits! Jobs allegiance is ultimately for personal profit, not due to Gods worth!


Quid Pro Quo Christianity? Latin phrase meaning "something for something"

[Mal 3:13-16, 18 13 "Your words have been arrogant against Me," says the LORD. "Yet you say, 'What have we spoken against You?' 14 "You have said, 'It is pointless to serve God; and what benefit [is it for us] that we have done what He required, and that we have walked in mourning before the LORD of armies?"

15 'So now we call the arrogant blessed; not only are the doers of wickedness built up, but they also put God to the test and escape [punishment.]' 16 Then those who feared the LORD spoke to one another, and the LORD listened attentively and heard [it,] and a book of remembrance was written before Him for those who fear the LORD and esteem His name. ... 18 So you will again distinguish between the righteous and the wicked, between one who serves God and one who does not serve Him.

No one in his right mind wants to suffer! Some think we Christians are masochistic, we're not. We simply understand it's a reality of our world and we must accept God's sovereignty in it all.

**How do you deal with suffering?**

Many refuse to consider it!

They "cant" visit people in the hospital

They retort to every heartfelt complaint with trite sayings they have never had to live themselves

They avoid messages on Job or suffering with the sneaky hope that ignoring these issues will help them tap dance thru life and escape them when really they are simply dooming themselves to being unprepared for that day!

They rarely IF ever can engage in a real discussion of serious matters, everything is always a joke, fun or escape

[Job 6:2 KJV] 2 Oh that my grief were throughly weighed, and my calamity laid in the balances together!

[Joe 2:13 NIV] 13 Rend your heart and not your garments. Return to the LORD your God, for he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and he relents from sending calamity.

[Pro 24:16 ESV] 16 for the righteous falls seven times and rises again, but the wicked stumble in times of calamity.

[Ecc 7:13-15 NASB20] 13 Consider the work of God, For who is able to straighten what He has bent? 14 **On the day of prosperity be happy, But on the day of adversity consider: God has made the one as well as the other So that a person will not discover anything [that will come] after him.** 15 I have seen everything during my lifetime of futility; there is a righteous person who perishes in his righteousness, and there is a wicked person who prolongs [his life] in his wickedness.

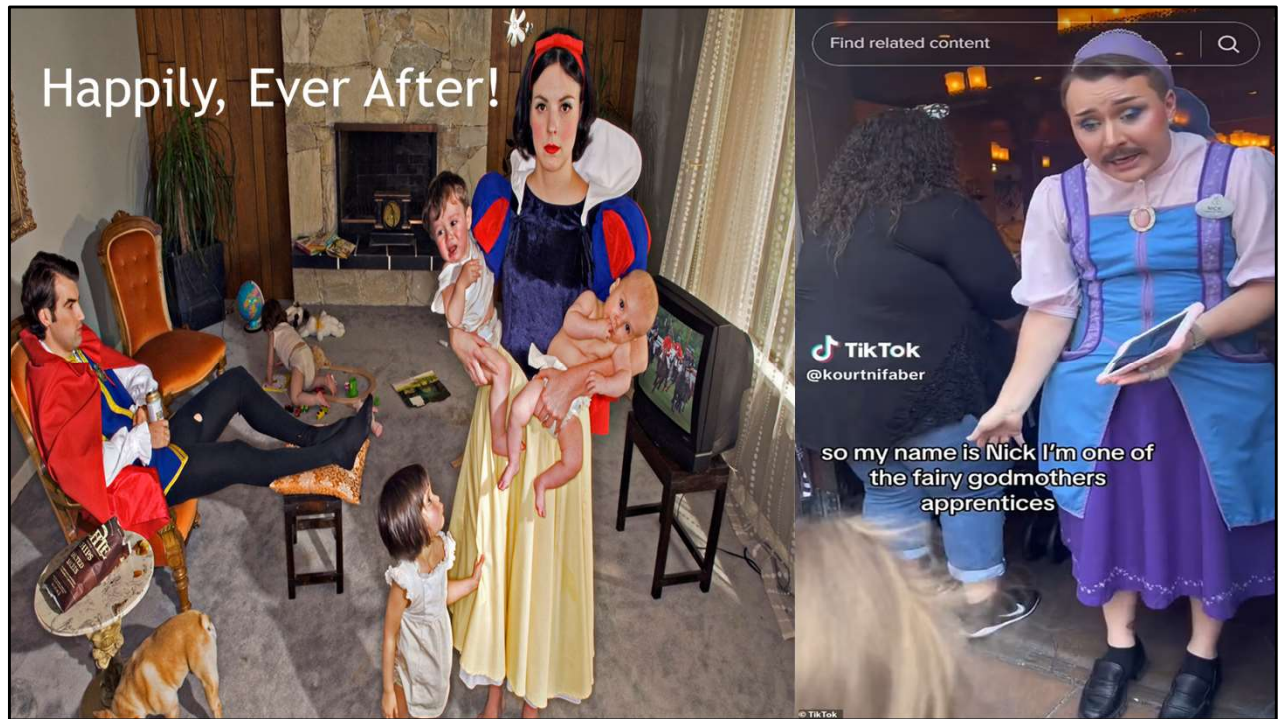

- Beelzebub needs permission! Before the Throne!
- The Devil is powerful and malevolent!

[Job 1:7 NASB20] 7 The LORD said to Satan, "From where do you come?" Satan answered the LORD and said, "From roaming about on the earth and walking around on it."

[Job 2:2 NASB20] 2 The LORD said to Satan, "Where have you come from?" Then Satan answered the LORD and said, "From roaming about on the earth and walking around on it."

**To deny the existence of Satan is like denying car accidents, cancer and Germs**

[1Pe 5:8 NASB20] 8 Be of sober [spirit,] be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

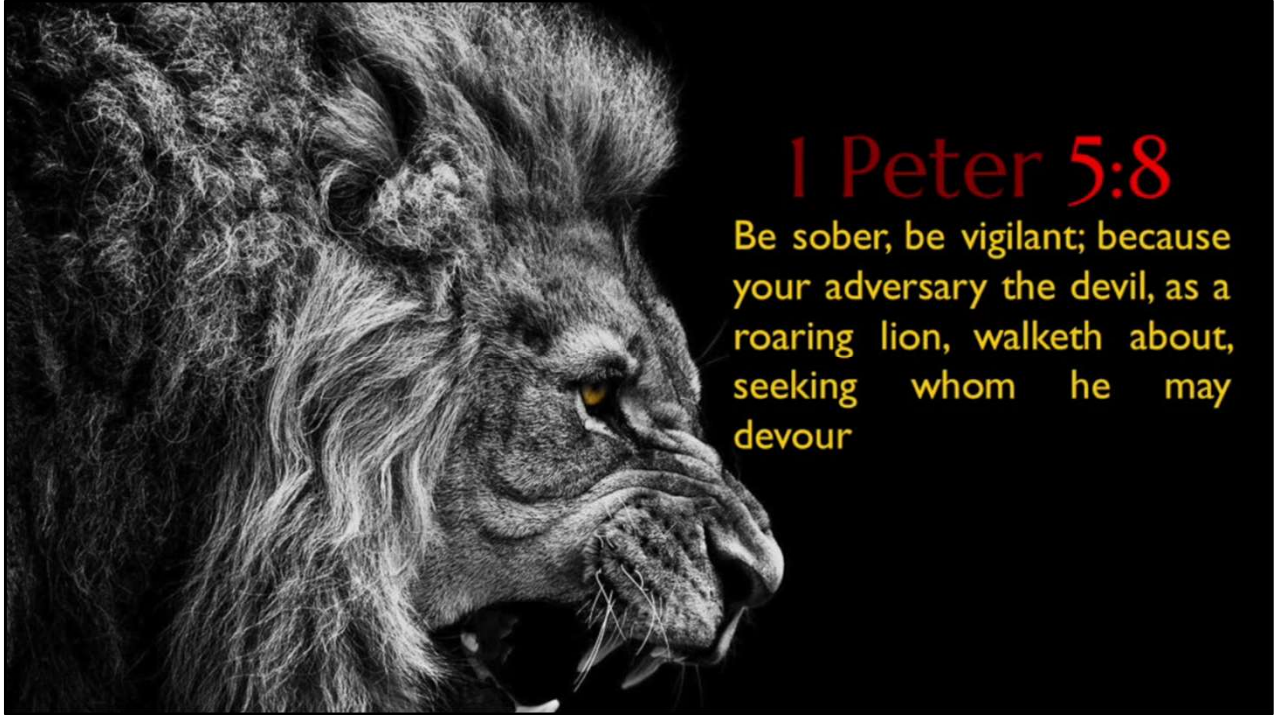
This is WAR! Spiritual warfare! But NOT ALL suffering is a direct satanic attack, be careful!

We don't typically teach a great deal on Satan for good reasons! Many people today don't believe in a real being called the devil! Or worse they do believe IN him.

[Zec 1:10-11 NASB20] 10 And the man who was standing among the myrtle trees responded and said, "These are the ones whom the LORD has sent to patrol the earth." 11 So they responded to the angel of the LORD who was standing among the myrtle trees and said, "We have patrolled the earth, and behold, all the earth is still and quiet."

[Zec 6:7 NASB20] 7 When the strong ones went out, they were eager to go to patrol the earth. And He said, "Go, patrol the earth." So they patrolled the earth.

[Mat 12:43 NASB20] 43 "Now when the unclean spirit comes out of a person, it passes through waterless places seeking rest, and does not find [it.]

### **Both Jesus and Satan are Lions?**

**Not because they are equal in any way BUT because Satan mimics Jesus! He is an antichrist, an imitation, a false Christ, Notice Satan Roars! Because he inspires fear! One of his favorite weapons! A Pride of Lions! Jesus speaks more with His actions than His words when it comes to his bite!**

**Rev.5 reveals Jesus as Lion and Lamb! More as the Lamb! Because the text speaks of His people who are saved by His blood and need not fear the Lion!**

[Rev 5:5-6 NLT] 5 But one of the twenty-four elders said to me, "Stop weeping! Look, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the heir to David's throne, has won the victory. He is worthy to open the scroll and its seven seals." 6 Then I saw a Lamb that looked as if it had been slaughtered, but it was now standing between the throne and the four living beings and among the twenty-four elders. He had seven horns and seven eyes, which represent the sevenfold Spirit of God that is sent out into every part of the earth.

[Gen 49:9-10 NLT] 9 Judah, my son, is a young lion that has finished eating its prey. Like a lion he crouches and lies down; like a lioness--who dares to rouse

him? 10 The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from his descendants, until the coming of the one to whom it belongs, the one whom all nations will honor.

[Num 24:9 NLT] 9 Like a lion, Israel crouches and lies down; like a lioness, who dares to arouse her? Blessed is everyone who blesses you, O Israel, and cursed is everyone who curses you."

[Heb 7:14 NLT] 14 What I mean is, our Lord came from the tribe of Judah, and Moses never mentioned priests coming from that tribe.

**Satan 54x in 47 vs. 1<sup>st</sup> time he's mentioned, by this name, in chronology is in Job! Adversary Devil/diabolos 34x in 32 vs. All in N.T. False Accuser/Slanderer! Serpent, Dragon, god of this world...**

[2Co 2:11 NKJV] 11 lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices.

[1Ch 21:1 NASB20] 1 Then Satan stood up against Israel and incited David to count

Israel.

[Job 1:6-9, 12 NASB20] 6 Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came among them. 7 The LORD said to Satan, "From where do you come?" Satan answered the LORD and said, "From roaming about on the earth and walking around on it." 8 The LORD said to Satan, "Have you considered My servant Job? For there is no one like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, fearing God and turning away from evil." 9 Then Satan answered the LORD, "Does Job fear God for nothing? ... 12 Then the LORD said to Satan, "Behold, all that he has is in your power; only do not reach out [and put] your hand on him." So Satan departed from the presence of the LORD.

[Job 2:1-4, 6-7 NASB20] 1 Again, there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came among them to present himself before the LORD. 2 The LORD said to Satan, "Where have you come from?" Then Satan answered the LORD and said, "From roaming about on the earth and walking around on it." 3 The LORD said to Satan, "Have you considered My servant Job? For there is no one like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man fearing God and turning away from evil. And he still holds firm to his integrity, although you incited Me against him to ruin him without cause." 4 Satan answered the LORD and said, "Skin for skin! Yes, all that a man has, he will give for his life. ... 6 So the LORD said to Satan, "Behold, he is in your power, only spare his life." 7 Then Satan went out from the presence of the LORD and struck Job with severe boils from the sole of his foot to the top of his head.

[Zec 3:1-2 NASB20] 1 Then he showed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the LORD, and Satan standing at his right to accuse him. 2 And the LORD said to Satan, "The LORD rebuke you, Satan! Indeed, the LORD who has chosen Jerusalem rebuke you! Is this not a log snatched from the fire?"

[Mat 4:10 NASB20] 10 Then Jesus said to him, "Go away, Satan! For it is written: 'YOU SHALL WORSHIP THE LORD YOUR GOD, AND SERVE HIM ONLY.'"

[Mat 12:26 NASB20] 26 "And if Satan is casting out Satan, he has become divided against himself; how then will his kingdom stand?

[Mat 16:23 NASB20] 23 But He turned and said to Peter, "Get behind Me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to Me; for you are not setting your mind on God's purposes, but men's."

[Mar 1:13 NASB20] 13 And He was in the wilderness for forty days, being tempted by Satan; and He was with the wild animals, and the angels were serving Him.

[Mar 3:23, 26 NASB20] 23 And [so] He called them to Himself and [began] speaking to them in parables: "How can Satan cast out Satan? ... 26 "And if Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand, but he is finished!

[Jhn 13:27 NASB20] 27 After this, Satan then entered him. Therefore Jesus said to him, "What you are doing, do [it] quickly."

[Act 5:3 NASB20] 3 But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and to keep back [some] of the proceeds of the land?

[Act 26:18 NASB20] 18 to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

[Rom 16:20 NASB20] 20 The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you.

[1Co 5:5 NASB20] 5 [I have decided] to turn such a person over to Satan for the destruction of his body, so that his spirit may be saved on the day of the Lord.

[1Co 7:5 NASB20] 5 Stop depriving one another, except by agreement for a time so that you may devote yourselves to prayer, and come together again so that Satan will not tempt you because of your lack of self-control.

[2Co 2:11 NASB20] 11 so that no advantage would be taken of us by Satan, for we are not ignorant of his schemes.

[2Co 11:14 NASB20] 14 No wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light.

[2Co 12:7] Because of the extraordinary [greatness] of the revelations, for this reason, to keep me from exalting myself, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to torment me--to keep me from exalting myself!

[1Th 2:18 NASB20] 18 For we wanted to come to you--I, Paul, more than once--and Satan hindered us.

[2Th 2:9 NASB20] 9 [that is,] the one whose coming is in accord with the activity of Satan, with all power and false signs and wonders,

[1Ti 1:20 NASB20] 20 Among these are Hymenaeus and Alexander, whom I have handed over to Satan, so that they will be taught not to blaspheme.

[1Ti 5:15 NASB20] 15 for some have already turned away to follow Satan.

[Rev 2:9, 13, 24 NASB20] 9 'I know your tribulation and your poverty (but you are rich), and the slander by those who say they are Jews, and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan. ... 13 'I know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is; and you hold firmly to My name, and did not deny My faith even in the days of Antipas, My witness, My faithful one, who was killed among you, where Satan dwells. ... 24 'But I say to you, the rest who are in Thyatira, who do not hold this teaching, who

have not known the deep things of Satan, as they call them--I place no other burden on you.

[Rev 3:9 NASB20] 9 'Behold, I will make [those] of the synagogue of Satan, who say that they are Jews and are not, but lie--I will make them come and bow down before your feet, and [make them] know that I have loved you.

[Rev 12:9 NASB20] 9 And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

[Rev 20:2, 7 NASB20] 2 And he took hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; ... 7 When the thousand years are completed, Satan will be released from his prison,

[Mat 4:1, 5, 8, 11 NASB20] 1 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil[G1228]. ... 5 Then the devil[G1228] took Him along into the holy city and had Him stand on the pinnacle of the temple, ... 8 Again, the devil[G1228] took Him along to a very high mountain and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory; ... 11 Then the devil[G1228] left Him; and behold, angels came and [began to] serve Him.

[Mat 13:39 NASB20] 39 and the enemy who sowed them is the devil[G1228], and the harvest is the end of the age; and the reapers are angels.

[Mat 25:41 NASB20] 41 "Then He will also say to those on His left, 'Depart from Me, you accursed people, into the eternal fire which has been prepared for the devil[G1228] and his angels;

[Luk 4:2-3, 6, 13 NASB20] 2 for forty days, being tempted by the devil[G1228]. And He ate nothing during those days, and when they had ended, He was hungry. 3 And the devil[G1228] said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, tell this stone to become bread." ... 6 And the devil[G1228] said to Him, "I will give You all this domain and its glory, for it has been handed over to me, and I give it to whomever I want. ... 13 And [so] when the devil[G1228] had finished every temptation, he left Him until an opportune time.

[Luk 8:12 NASB20] 12 "And those beside the road are the ones who have heard, then the devil[G1228] comes and takes away the word from their heart, so that they will not believe and be saved.

[Jhn 6:70 NASB20] 70 Jesus answered them, "Did I Myself not choose you, the twelve? And [yet] one of you is a devil[G1228]."

[Jhn 8:44 NASB20] 44 "You are of [your] father the devil[G1228], and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth because there is no truth in him. Whenever he tells a lie, he speaks from his own [nature,] because he is a liar and the father of lies.

[Jhn 13:2 NASB20] 2 And during supper, the devil[G1228] having already put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, [the son] of Simon, to betray Him,

[Act 10:38 NASB20] 38 "[You know of] Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and [how] He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil[G1228], for God was with Him.

[Act 13:10 NASB20] 10 and said, "You who are full of all deceit and fraud, you son of the devil[G1228], you enemy of all righteousness, will you not stop making crooked the straight ways of the Lord?

[Eph 4:27 NASB20] 27 and do not give the devil[G1228] an opportunity.

[Eph 6:11 NASB20] 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil[G1228].

[1Ti 3:6-7, 11 NASB20] 6 [and] not a new convert, so that he will not become conceited and fall into condemnation incurred by the devil[G1228]. 7 And he must have a good reputation with those outside [the church,] so that he will not fall into disgrace and the snare of the devil[G1228]. ... 11 Women [must] likewise [be] dignified, not malicious[G1228] gossips[G1228], but temperate, faithful in all things.

[2Ti 2:26 NASB20] 26 and they may come to their senses [and escape] from the snare of the devil[G1228], having been held captive by him to do his will.

[2Ti 3:3 NASB20] 3 unloving, irreconcilable, malicious[G1228] gossips[G1228], without self-control, brutal, haters of good,

[Tit 2:3 NASB20] 3 Older women likewise [are to be] reverent in their behavior, not malicious[G1228] gossips[G1228] nor enslaved to much wine, teaching what is good,

[Heb 2:14 NASB20] 14 Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, so that through death He might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil[G1228],

[Jas 4:7 NASB20] 7 Submit therefore to God. But resist the devil[G1228], and he will flee from you.

[Rev 2:10 NASB20] 10 'Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil[G1228] is about to throw some of you into prison, so that you will be tested, and you will have tribulation for ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.

[Rev 12:9, 12 NASB20] 9 And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil[G1228] and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him. ... 12 "For this reason, rejoice, you heavens and you who dwell in them. Woe to the earth and the sea, because the devil[G1228] has come down to you with great wrath, knowing that he has [only] a short time."

[Rev 20:2, 10 NASB20] 2 And he took hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is
