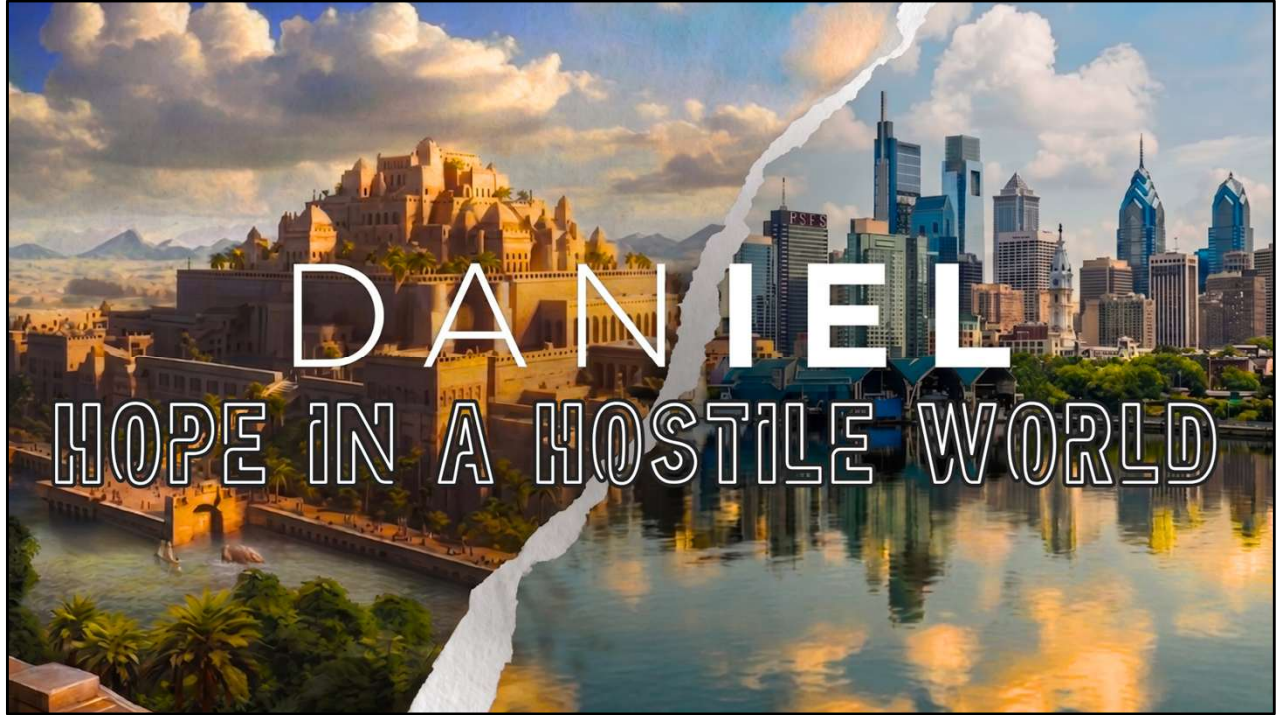
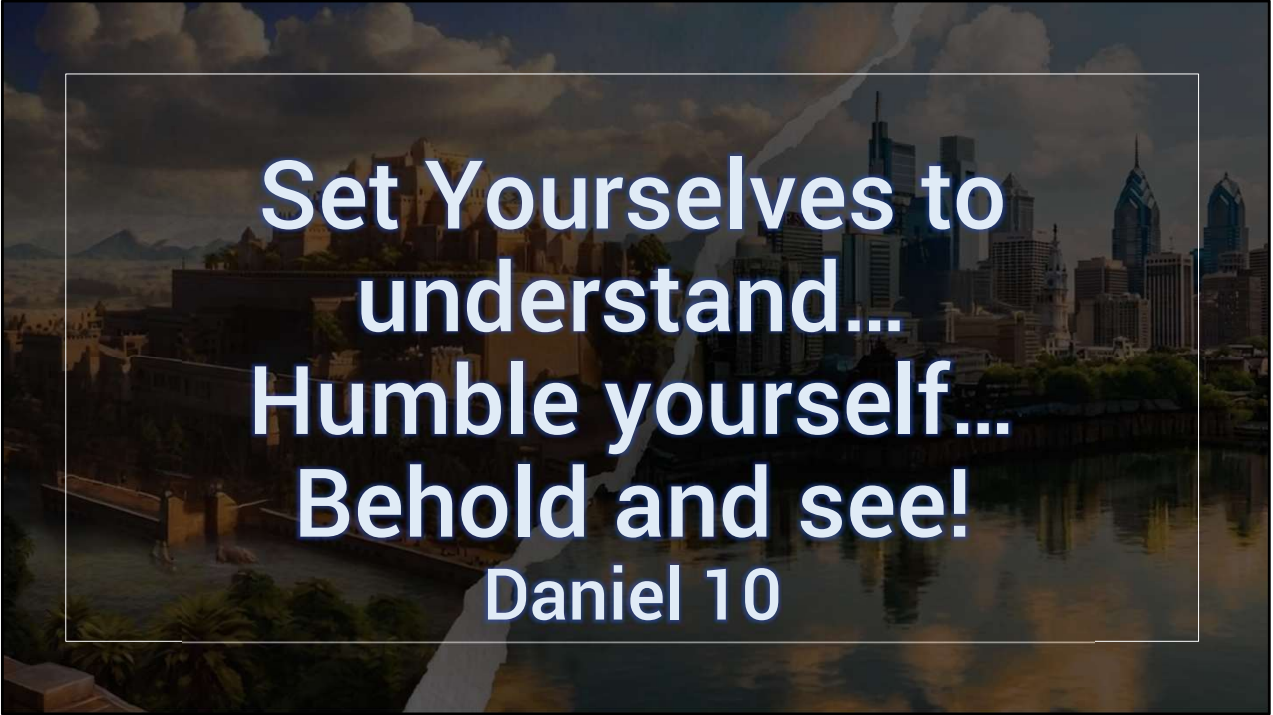




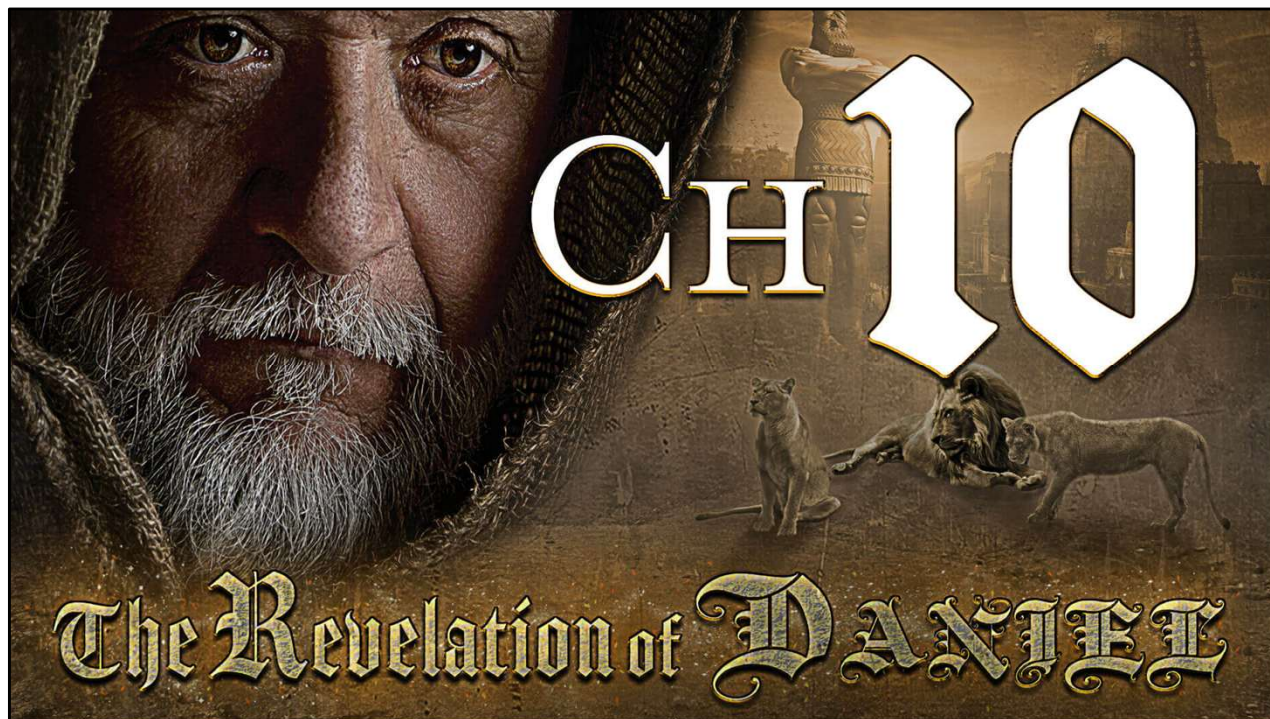

[Dan 10:2-3, 5 ESV] 2 In those days I, Daniel, was mourning for three weeks. 3 I ate no delicacies, no meat or wine entered my mouth, nor did I anoint myself at all, for the full three weeks. ... 5 I lifted up my eyes and looked, and behold, a man clothed in linen, with a belt of fine gold from Uphaz around his waist.

[Dan 10:12 ESV] 12 Then he said to me, "**Fear not, Daniel**, for **from the first day** that you set your heart to understand and humbled yourself before your God, your words have been heard, and I have come because of your words.



The Revelation of Daniel. A good title!

The final vision given to Daniel came in the third year of the reign of Cyrus which was 536 b.c. Exiles had returned from Babylon and had begun rebuilding the temple. (Perhaps Daniel had not returned with the exiles because of his age.) Israel's captivity had ended. Jerusalem was being reoccupied, and the nation seemed to be at peace. The revelation in the vision given to Daniel on this occasion shattered any hope the prophet might have had that Israel would enjoy her new freedom and peace for long. For God revealed that the nation would be involved in many conflicts (a great war). Understanding the significance of the vision, Daniel fasted for three weeks (lit., "three sevens of days

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Daniel sought God!

- Biblical fasting is intentional, intense and inquiring
 - It exposes the impulses, power and control of the flesh!
 - Use hunger urges to pray, study and listen
 - Spend normal food prep/eating times to seek God
 - You can also FAST from other desires (Screens, sports ...)

Hunger pangs speak! Do you hear the still small voice of...Hangry!
Does your belly or your tongue dictate your spirit? Or does the HS bear fruit in you always?

TEN CHALLENGES IN 10 DAYS

We're excited for you to join us on this ten day challenge. The Isaiah fast is meant to be a fast of heart and hands and not of want. Below is a guide taken from Isaiah chapter 58 in which each day of the fast has suggestions for how to accomplish the Isaiah 58 challenge. Doing this with heart motivation takes planning. We encourage you to take some time and plan out your fast.

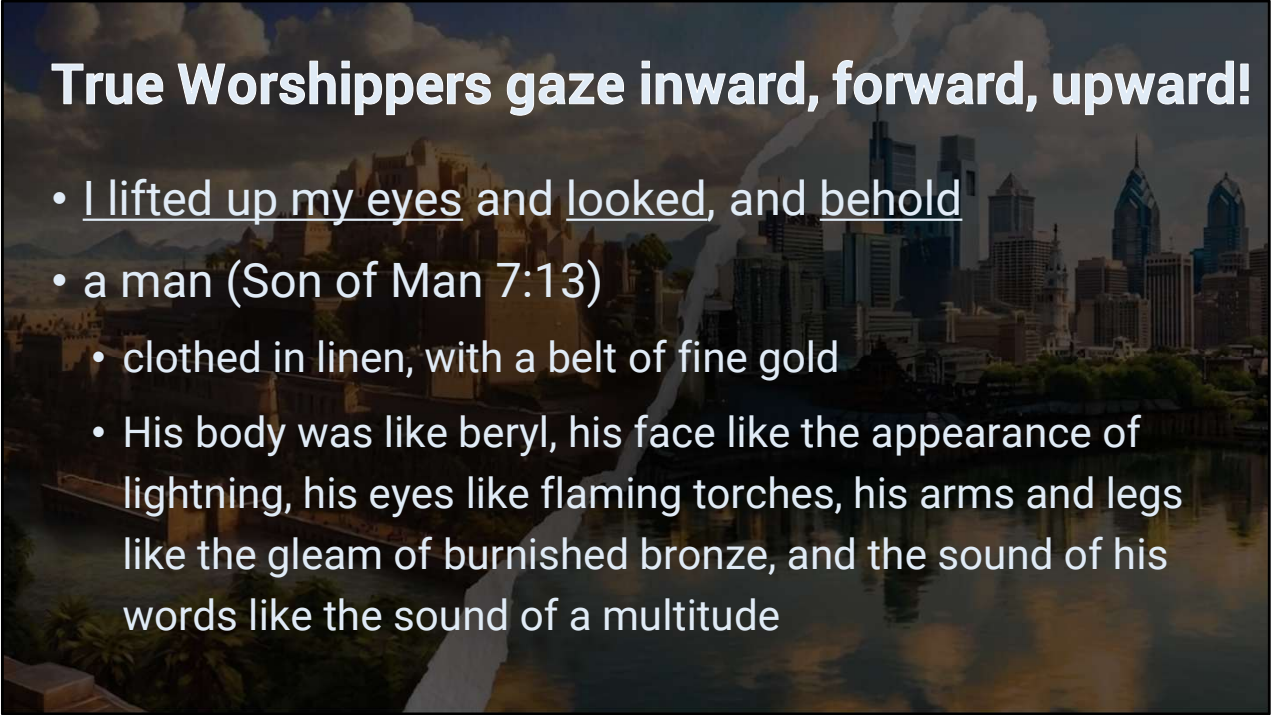

Some people are trying to monetize bible concepts to their own profit! IT wasn't about losing weight or health!

IF Fasting doesn't heighten your Spiritual appetites and affections and bring change, to obedience and ministry. If it doesn't bring enlightenment/encouragement and a better perspective. It failed!

[Isa 58:1-10, 13-14 ESV] 1 "Cry aloud; do not hold back; lift up your voice like a trumpet; declare to my people their transgression, to the house of Jacob their sins. 2 Yet they seek me daily and delight to know my ways, as if they were a nation that did righteousness and did not forsake the judgment of their God; they ask of me righteous judgments; they delight to draw near to God. 3 'Why have we fasted, and you see it not? Why have we humbled ourselves, and you take no knowledge of it?' Behold, in the day of your fast you seek your own pleasure, and oppress all your workers. 4 Behold, you fast only to quarrel and to fight and to hit with a wicked fist. Fasting like yours this day will not make your voice to be heard on high. 5 Is such the fast that I choose, a day for a person to humble himself? Is it to bow down his head like a reed, and to spread sackcloth and ashes under him? Will you call this a fast, and a day acceptable to the LORD? 6 "Is not this the fast that I choose: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the straps of the yoke, to let the oppressed go free,

and to break every yoke? 7 Is it not to share your bread with the hungry and bring the homeless poor into your house; when you see the naked, to cover him, and not to hide yourself from your own flesh? 8 Then shall your light break forth like the dawn, and your healing shall spring up speedily; your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the LORD shall be your rear guard. 9 **Then you shall call, and the LORD will answer; you shall cry, and he will say, 'Here I am.'** If you take away the yoke from your midst, the pointing of the finger, and speaking wickedness, 10 if you pour yourself out for the hungry and satisfy the desire of the afflicted, then shall your light rise in the darkness and your gloom be as the noonday. ... 13 **"If you turn back your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on my holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight and the holy day of the LORD honorable; if you honor it, not going your own ways, or seeking your own pleasure, or talking idly; 14 then you shall take delight in the LORD, and I will make you ride on the heights of the earth; I will feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father, for the mouth of the LORD has spoken."**

[Dan 7:13 ESV] 13 "I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came one like a son of man, and he came to the Ancient of Days and was presented before him.

Inward – fasting, Scouring for hidden sin

Forward, instead of backward, Phil.3 forgetting those things behind. Not worshipping or running from the past

Upward – Like a child to their Father

Some Bible students say that the man was the preincarnate Christ because v 1, p 1366 of (a) the similarity of the description here to that of Christ in Revelation 1:13–16, (b) the response of Daniel and his friends (Dan. 10:7–8), and (c) the fact that this “Man” may be the same as the “Son of Man” in 7:13 and the “Man” in 8:16. On the other hand, in favor of this messenger being an angel is the improbability of Christ being hindered by a prince (demon) of Persia (10:13) and needing the help of the angel Michael, and the fact that the person is giving a message from heaven.

It is not clear how many supernatural beings are involved in the scene. In 12:5–6 there are two others apart from the man in linen, and so it may also be here, but the seer does not make it explicit. The man in linen (vv 5–6) may be Michael and the subsequent speaker Gabriel, though—if so—it is odd that the names are not actually applied to the figures, nor are the links noted (contrast 9:21); nor does the reference to Michael in 11:1 mention the fact that he is present. The man in linen is described in more awesome terms than have been used of Gabriel previously, like those used of God himself in Ezek 1. But they need not indicate that the person *is God, or represents God (like the messenger of Yahweh, e.g., Gen 16), only that the passages have this literary connection*

Daniel. To the left the Ancient of Days Dan.7 is strikingly similar to Jesus in Rev.1, as is the Angel in 10:5-6

Rev 1:13-16 and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man, clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash around his chest. 14 The hairs of his head were white, like white wool, like snow. His eyes were like a flame of fire, 15 his feet were like burnished bronze, refined in a furnace, and his voice was like the roar of many waters. 16 In his right hand he held seven stars, from his mouth came a sharp two-edged sword, and his face was like the sun shining in full strength.

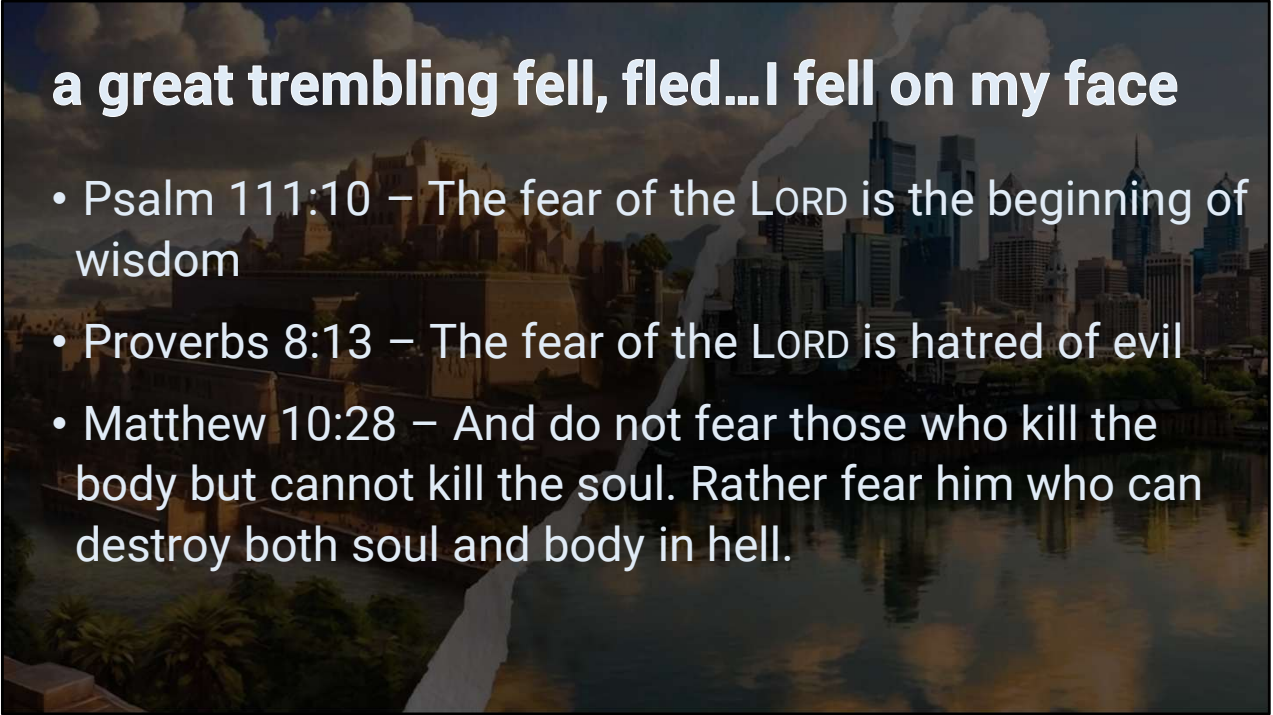

Daniel and his men fell in fear. Do people today “Fear the Lord” appropriately? Do you?!

[Act 5:9-11, 13-14 ESV] 9 But Peter said to her, "How is it that you have agreed together to test the Spirit of the Lord? Behold, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out." 10 Immediately she fell down at his feet and breathed her last. When the young men came in they found her dead, and they carried her out and buried her beside her husband. 11 **And great fear came upon the whole church** and upon all who heard of these things. ... 13 **None of the rest dared join them, but the people held them in high esteem.** 14 **And more than ever believers were added to the Lord,** multitudes of both men and women,

LORD are true, and righteous altogether.

[Pro 19:23 ESV] 23 The fear of the LORD leads to life, and whoever has it rests satisfied; he will not be visited by harm.

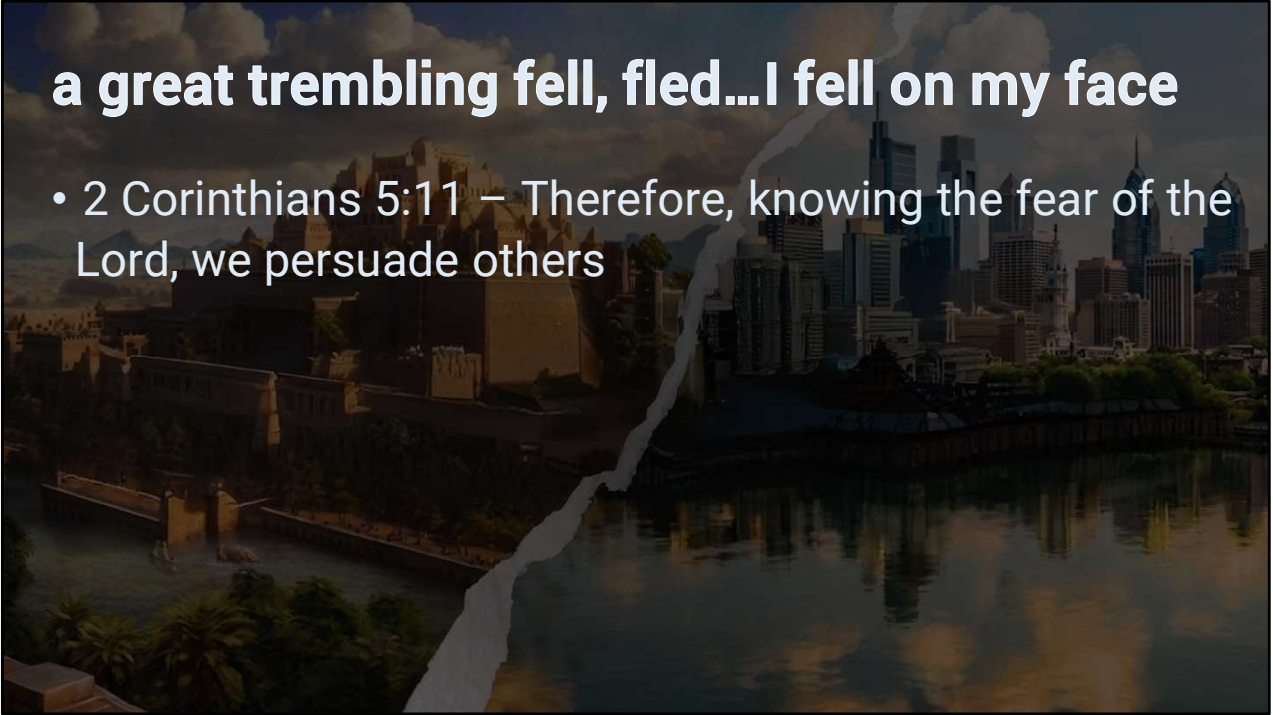
[Pro 22:4 ESV] 4 The reward for humility and fear of the LORD is riches and honor and life.

Proverbs 14:2 "He that walks in his uprightness **FEARS THE LORD**"

Did you hear that? He that walks in his uprightness "fears the Lord." We may say, he that does not walk in his uprightness, does not fear the Lord.

Proverbs 14:16 "A WISE MAN FEARS, and departs from Evil: But the Fool Rages, and is Confident."

Some time ago, a certain gentleman stated that we should not fear the Lord, but only love Him. As he continued sharing his views, his words began to approach blasphemy of the Holy Spirit—as he seemed to be connecting things of the Spirit of God with Satan. He was warned twice. This gentleman maintained that he loved God, yet he did not seem to be afraid to speak such words. The fear of God did not appear to be in him at all.

Matthew 10:28 Jesus tells us, "Fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather **FEAR HIM** which is able to destroy both soul and body in Hell."

It is written:

Ecclesiastes 8:11-13 "Because sentence against an evil work is not executed

speedily, therefore the heart of the sons of men is fully set in them to do evil. Though a sinner do evil an hundred times, and his *days* be prolonged, yet surely I know that it shall be well with them that **FEAR GOD**, which fear before him: But it shall not be well with the wicked, neither shall he prolong *his* days, *which are* as a shadow; because he feareth not before God."

God is trying to tell you to **FEAR HIM**, for it will not be well with those who do not.

The Bible tells us of those who honor God with their lips, but do not fear Him.

Although they may seem to honor God, their heart is really far from Him.

[Isaiah 29:13](#) "Forasmuch as this people draw near *me* with their mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far from me, and **THEIR FEAR TOWARD ME IS TAUGHT BY THE PRECEPT OF MEN.**"

Angelology

[Rev 14:6-7, 13 ESV] 6 Then I saw another angel flying directly overhead, with an eternal gospel to proclaim to those who dwell on earth, to every nation and tribe and language and people. 7 And he said with a loud voice, "Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come, and worship him who made heaven and earth, the sea and the springs of water." ... 13 And I heard a voice from heaven saying, "Write this: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on." "Blessed indeed," says the Spirit, "that they may rest from their labors, for their deeds follow them!"

There are Guardian Angels!

Psalms 34:7: "The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them." [\[1\]](#), [\[2\]](#)

Psalms 91:11–12: "For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot

against a stone." [1, 2]

Matthew 18:10: Jesus says, "See that you do not despise one of these little ones. For I tell you that their angels in heaven always see the face of my Father in heaven." [1, 2]

Hebrews 1:14: "Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation?" [1, 2]

Daniel in the Lions' Den: An angel shut the mouths of the lions to protect Daniel (Daniel 6:22).

Peter's Prison Release: An angel woke Peter and led him safely past guards out of prison (Acts 12:7–11).

The Wilderness Journey: God promised to send an angel ahead of the Israelites to guard them on the way to the Promised Land (Exodus 23:20)

[Mat 18:10 ESV] 10 "See that you do not despise one of these little ones. For I tell you that in heaven their angels always see the face of my Father who is in heaven.

[Mat 22:30 ESV] 30 For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven.

[Mat 25:41 ESV] 41 "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels.

[Heb 13:2 ESV] 2 Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

[Luk 10:17-20 ESV] 17 The seventy-two returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in your name!" 18 And he said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. 19 Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you. 20 Nevertheless, do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven."
