Does it Pass the Smell Test? - James 1:22-27 -

Ever smell a dead, decaying body? [Jas 2:17 NASB20] 17 In the same way, faith also, if it has no works, is dead, [being] by itself.

[Eph 5:2 WEB] 2 And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savor.

Jesus didn't state His love, He "staked" it!

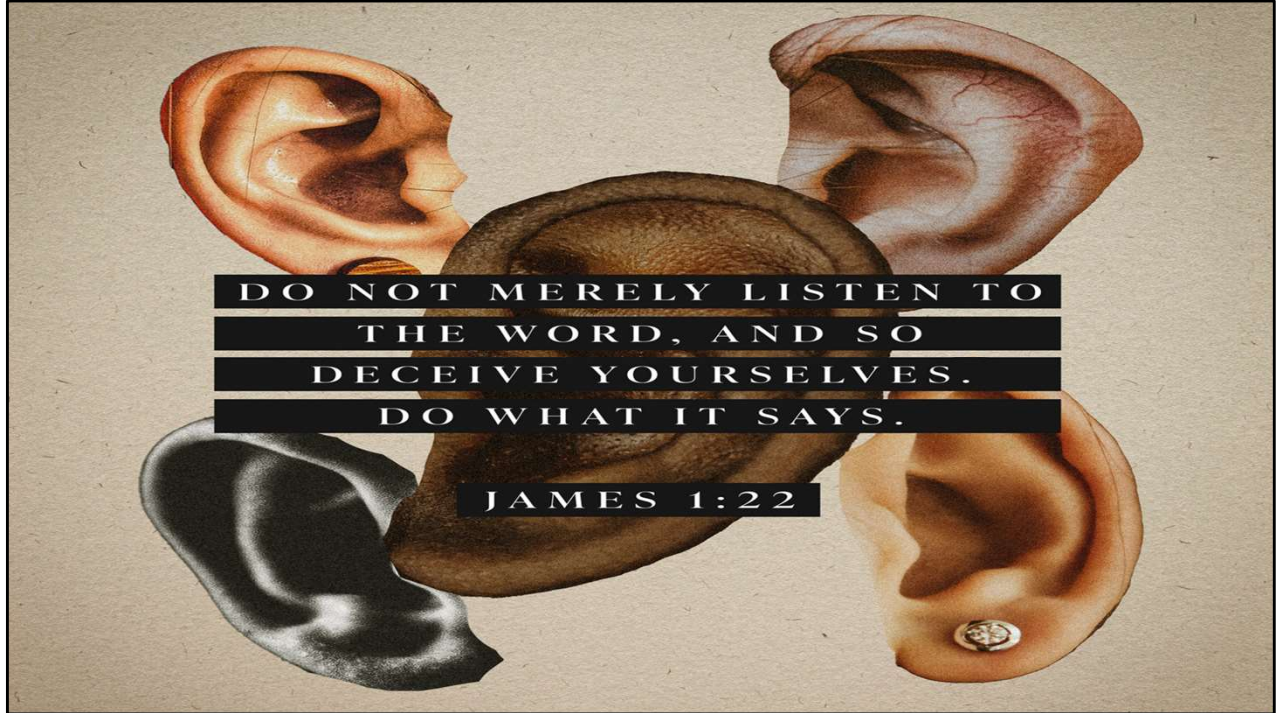
Jesus' Love wasn't so demonstrable in words but in a bloody cross! How have you shown him your love in return?

James 1:22-27

- What are areas in your life where you “deceive yourself”? We ALL do, to some measure.
- What metaphor lesson is James using when he mentions a Mirror? 1:22-25
- Did you know that mirrors, as we know them, are relatively new, what would it be like IF we couldn't see ourselves clearly?
- What are some famous literary story's about “dangerous or poor reflections/mirrors”?
- Is it possible to be a true Christian who “lives” in brazen sin and unrepentant disobedience? Why are so many “christians” living in immorality”? Are they really saved? 1Jn.2:29, 3:7-10

Love is Proven 22, don't be "Worthless" 26

[Jas 1:12, 16, 19, 22, 26 NASB20] 12 Blessed is a man who perseveres under trial; for once he has been **approved**, he will receive the crown of life which [the Lord] has promised to those who love Him. ... 16 **Do not be deceived**, my beloved brothers [and sisters.] ... 19 **You know [this,]** my beloved brothers [and sisters.] Now everyone **must be** quick to hear, slow to speak, [and] slow to anger; ... 22 But **prove yourselves** doers of the word, and not just hearers who **deceive themselves**. ... 26 If anyone **thinks himself** to be religious, yet does not bridle his tongue but **deceives his [own] heart**, this person's religion is **worthless**.

Faith without works is Dead!

Its like the Avid Sports commentators listener who thinks He is an Exeprt in Football, criticizing Jalen Hurts, when he himself has never played a down!

The Grand Deception!

- “not just hearers who **deceive themselves.**” - 1:22
- Matthew 7:22-23 - “**Many will say to Me on that day, ‘Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?’** “And then I will declare to them, ‘**I never knew you; LEAVE ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.**’

He saves us from??? Hell? Yes, BUT NO. From our sin and sinfulness! Why do we ONLY think of our redemption in terms of our escape and NOT His ownership! Our eternal benefit but not the loyalty that He deserves?!

Saves us to?? Love Him, Obey Him, Serve Him, forsake sin!

There is not a greater concern and quandary than a Pastor who's concerned for those under his care who are self deceived about their souls!

2. Will Say - words are cheap, Lip service. Isa.29:13, Mt.15:8
3. To ME, Lord, Lord, - They are claiming to be Christ followers
4. Did we Not, The works of humans do not save us! **Not by works of righteousness we have done** Titus 3:5. For/Against/perform! Preach in His name! Preacher/pastor/priests! Religious Cast out demons -

Nevertheless, the firm foundation of God stands, having this seal: "The Lord knows those who are His;" and, "Everyone who names the name of the Lord is to keep away from wickedness."

The greatest deception of all is seen in Mt.7, where so many are so wrong in the most consequential of ways! (Eternal wrath)

Picture of Dorian Gray, moral fantasy novel by Irish writer Oscar Wilde, published in an early form in Lippincott's Monthly Magazine in 1890. The novel, the only one written by Wilde, had six additional chapters when it was released as a book in 1891. The work, an archetypal tale of a young man who purchases eternal youth at the expense of his soul, was a romantic exposition of Wilde's own Aestheticism.

The Picture of Dorian Gray tells the story of a young, beautiful man who trades his soul for eternal youth, then descends further and further into a moral abyss – until he discovers there is, after all, a price to pay for his actions.

Wilde himself admits, in a letter to the St. James's Gazette, that Dorian Gray “is a story with a moral. And the moral is this: All excess, as well as all renunciation, brings its own punishment” (Wilde 248). Why does Dorian hide the portrait in the attic?

When the picture begins to deteriorate in line with his morals, Dorian hides it in his attic to prevent anyone seeing its terrible decay. After twenty years of various excesses, Dorian still looks like he did when he was eighteen, but the

portrait has become foully distorted; a loathsome vision of his shrivelling soul.

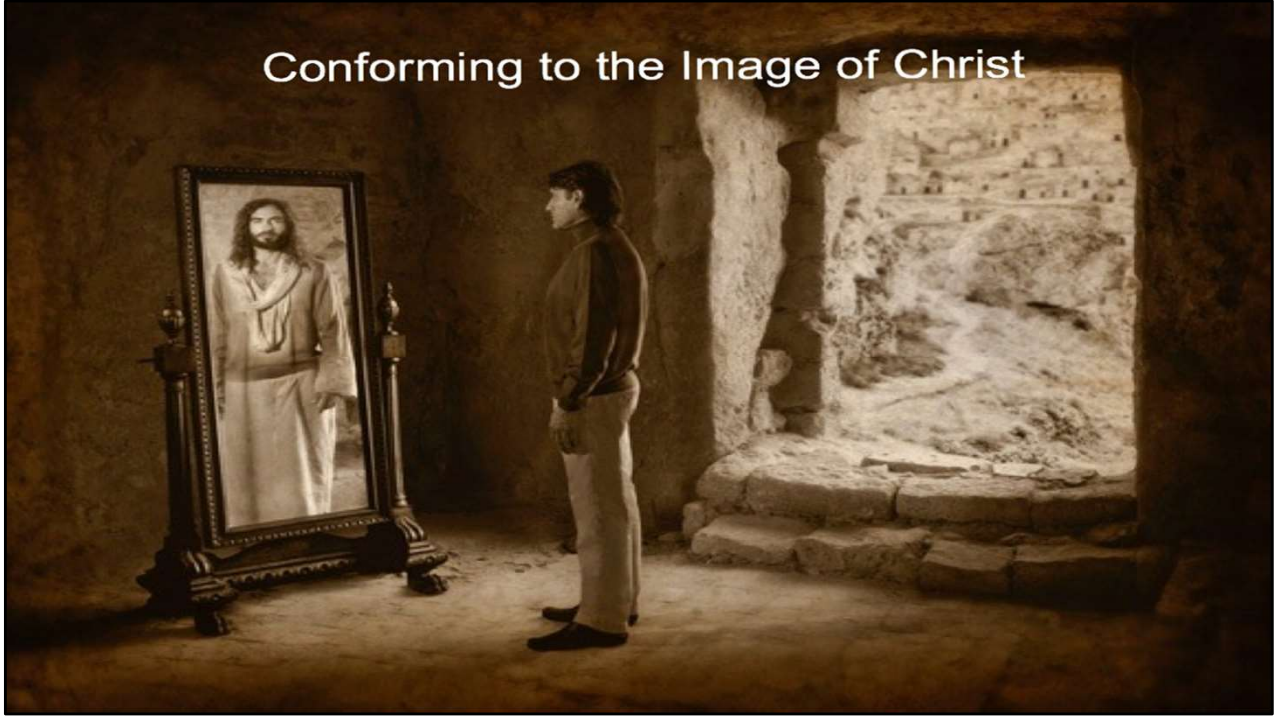

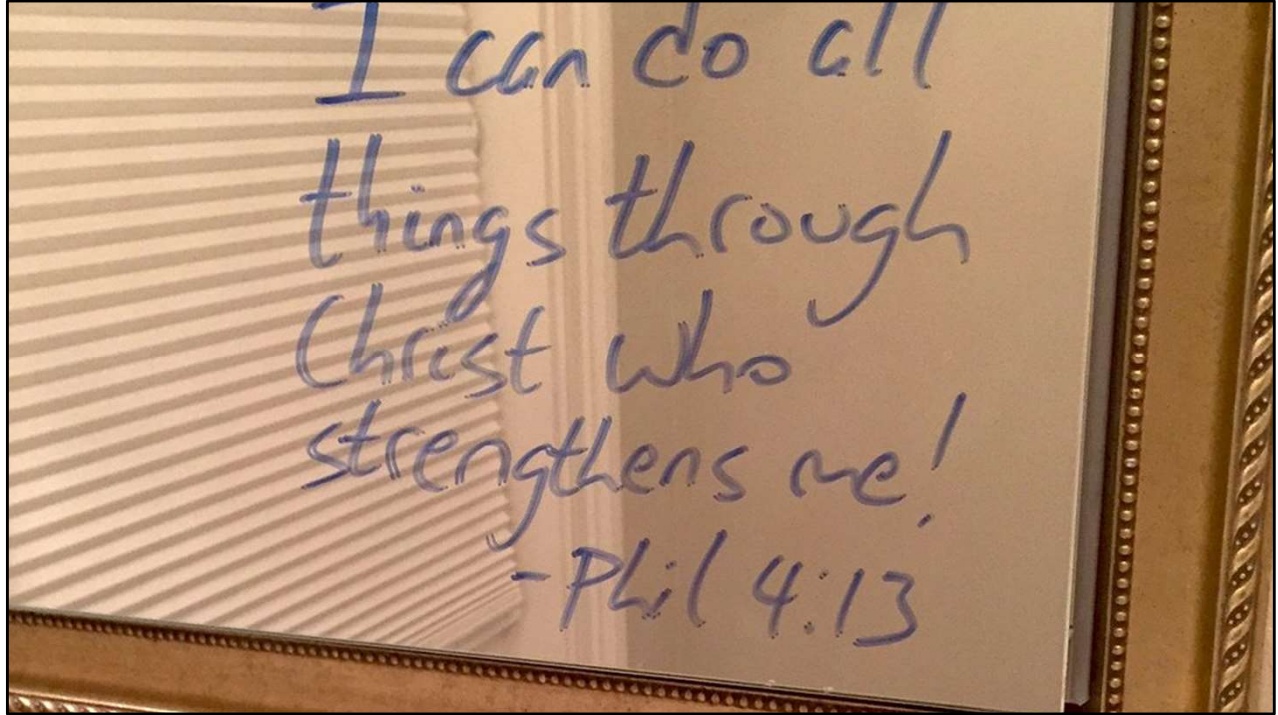
